

## LEGAL DEED DESCRIPTION MICHAEL E. AND MARY C. MINSHALL PART OF LOT 17

11 . ...

Real estate situated in the Village of Plain City; Darby Township of Madison County, Ohio; in the Virginia Military Survey number 5128; being part of Lot 17 of Pleasant Valley Addition (Plat Book 1, page 3), said lot owned by Michael E. and Mary C. Minshall (Deed Record 276, page 722); and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron rod set on the north line of East Main Street (60 foot wide right-of-way) at the southeast corner of said Lot 17. Also being the southwest corner of Lot 16 which is also owned by Michael E. and Mary C. Minshall (same deed reference), and the True Point of Beginning.

Thence North 85 deg.-40'-00" West (assumed bearing), 26.26 feet along said north line of East Main Street to an iron rod set.

Thence North 04 deg.-12'-00" East, 198.00 feet to an iron rod set on the south line of the original 105.27 pole tract of Jennifer Louise Minshall Thomas (Deed Record 267, page 230 & Official Record 113, page 1506).

Thence South 85 deg.-40'-00" East, 26.26 feet along said south line to an iron rod set on the northwest corner of said Lot 16 of Pleasant Valley Addition.

Thence South 04 deg.-12'-00" West, 198.00 feet along the west line of said Lot 16 to the True Point of Beginning.

Bearing assumed from Deed Record 185, page 19. The tract as described from an actual field survey performed on or about May 01, 2002, by Registered Surveyor Joseph P. Priday (S-7277), contains **0.119 acre**, more or less, subject to all previous easements and rights-of-way of record. All iron rods set are 1/2" x 30" with plastic I.D. caps. The plat of survey is on file in the map room of the Madison County Engineer.
