Beginning at a ¾ inch T-Bar found in the southeast right-of-way line of U.S. Route 42 (LaFayette Street), said T-Bar being at the westernmost corner of said 4.328 acres, said T-Bar also being at the northernmost corner of a 2.8657 acre tract conveyed to Swifty Transportation Inc. by Official Record 102 Page 172;

Thence, with said southeast right-of-way line, North 39 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 185.00 feet to a iron pin and cap set, said iron pin and cap being the True Point of Beginning;

Thence, continuing with said southeast right-of-way line, North 39 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 60.00 feet to a iron pin and cap set;

Thence, through said 4.328 acres the following three (3) new courses:

- 1) South 50 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 233.00 feet to a iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 39 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 60.00 feet to a iron pin and cap set
- 3) North 50 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 233.00 feet; returning to the True Point of Beginning, containing 0.3209 acres more or less.

Bearings are based on the southeast right-of-way line of U.S. Route 42 (South 39 degrees 30 minutes West) as described in Volume 275 Page 132

Thence, with said northeast line, North 50 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 233.00 feet; returning to the point of beginning, containing 0.9896 acres more or less.
