Description of a 5.659 Acre LOT Split From a 32.121 Acre Tract Located in Virginia Military Survey 2445 Jefferson Township, Madison County, Ohio

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the intersection of Plain City-Georgesville Road (50 foot Right-of-way) and Roberts Road (40 foot Right-of-way), said railroad spike is 6.84 feet from the original intersection of Plain City-Georgesville Road;

thence S53°02'00"W, 1141.78 feet, along the centerline of Roberts Road to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence S33°59'25"E, 901.59 feet, into the said 32.121 acre tract, passing an iron pin set at 20.03 feet, the west end of a drainage easement at 224.70 feet and the west end of another drainage easement at 528.86 feet, to an iron pin set;

thence S53°00'55"W, 273.70 feet, passing the centerline of a drainage easement at 74.45 feet to a pin set in the east line of a property in the name of Nancy C. Matrjasich (Official Records 102, Page 251);

thence N34°00'04"W, 901.67 feet, along the east line of the said Matrjasich property, passing an iron pin set in the south Right-of-way of Roberts Road at 881.64 feet, to a railroad spike found in the centerline of Roberts Road;

thence N53°02'00"E. 273.86 feet, along the centerline of Roberts Road to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the intersection of Plain City-Georgesville Road (50 foot Right-of-way) and Roberts Road (40 foot Right-of-way), said railroad spike is 6.84 feet from the original intersection of Plain City-Georgesville Road;

thence S53°02'00"W, 101.48 feet, along the centerline of Roberts Road to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence S33°59'21"E, 1027.26 feet, along the west lines of properties in the names of Roger E. and Margeret E. Bennett (Deed Book 153, Page 31), Paul G. and Bonita Gardner (Official Records 25, Page 1054), Gertrude M. Miller (Official Records 49, Page 1136) and Micheal W. Coons (Official records 78, Page 1221), passing a 5/8" iron pipe found exposed 4" on the north side of a wood post at 20.04 feet and a ¾" iron pipe found on the southwest side of a wood post at 275.06 feet, to an iron pin set;

thence \$53°00'55"W, 275.38 feet, to an iron pin set;

thence S33°59'21"E, 726.38 feet, passing the west end of an easement for dramage at 263.76 feet, to an iron pin set in the south line of the said 32.121 acre tract;

thence \$53°03'18"W, 448.69 feet, along the north line of a property in the name of Carl Stephen Fladt (Official Records 52, Page 44) to an iron pin set at the northwest side of an 8" comer post;
