

EXHIBIT A DESCRIPTION OF A 305.390 ACRE TRACT NORTH OF GIERICH-LILLY ROAD, EAST OF OLMSTEAD ROAD FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO AND MADISON COUNTY, OHIO

Situated in the State of Ohio, Jefferson Township, Madison County and Pleasant Township, Franklin County, Virginia Military Survey Number 4752, and being a 305.390 acres out of a 352.079 acre tract conveyed to Edward P. Sidner, an undivided ½ interest by deed of record in Official Record 222969, Page B-02, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio and Volume 294, Page 0946, Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio, and conveyed to Jane E. Sidner, an undivided ½ interest by deed of record in Official Record 22969, Page A-20, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio and Volume 294, Page 0958, Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio (further shown and delineated upon Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof), and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at Franklin County Engineers Monument WE49, said monument being southwesterly, along the Franklin and Madison County line, a distance of 925.67 feet from Franklin County Engineers Monument WE52, said monument also being the True Point of Beginning of the tract of land herein described;

thence South 32 degrees 52 minutes 29 seconds East, leaving the said Franklin and Madison County line, passing Iron Pipes set at 104.97 feet, 604.97 feet, 1104.97 feet, 1604.97 feet, 2104.97 feet, and at 2604.97 feet, a total distance of 3,104.97 feet to an Iron Pipe set at the northwesterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to Don L. Hazel and Loretta R. Hazel by deed of record in Official Record 01273, Page J-14;

thence South 24 degrees 32 minutes 04 seconds East, passing an Iron Pipe set at 179.55 feet, a total distance of 679.55 feet to an Iron Pin found, said Iron Pin also being on the northwesterly line of a tract of land conveyed to Blanche Sheaf by deed of record in Official Record 10186, Page F-05;

thence South 56 degrees 54 minutes 40 seconds West, with the northwesterly line of the aforementioned Sheaf tract of land and passing an Iron Pipe set at 363.70 feet, a total distance of 863.70 feet to an ¼ inch Iron Pin found, said Iron Pin also being at the northwesterly corner of said Sheaf tract;

thence South 09 degrees 36 minutes 57 seconds East, with the westerly line of said Sheaf tract, a distance of 487.30 feet to an Iron Pipe set on the centerline of Gierich-Lilly Road;

thence South 65 degrees 23 minutes 13 seconds West, leaving the westerly line of said Sheaf tract and with the aforementioned centerline of Gierich-Lilly Road, a distance of 1,663.24 feet to a Pk Nail found, said Pk Nail also being at the southeasterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to John C. Urton by deed of record in Book 150, Page 1046 (Madison County);

thence North 27 degrees 58 minutes 37 seconds West, with the easterly line of the aforementioned Urton tract, passing an Iron Pipe set at 401.55 feet, a total distance of 901.55 feet to a capped Iron Pipe found (BAKER S5539);

thence North 59 degrees 34 minutes 22 seconds West, with the northeasterly line of said Urton tract, passing Iron Pipes set at 79.79 feet and 579.79 feet, a total distance of 1,079.79 feet to a capped Iron Pipe found (BAKER \$5539);

thence South 65 degrees 20 minutes 59 seconds West, with the northerly line of said Urton tract, passing an Iron Pipe set at 221.41 feet, a total distance of 721.41 feet to a capped Iron Pipe found (BAKER S5539), said Iron Pipe also being the northwesterly corner of said Urton tract;

thence North 25 degrees 12 minutes 25 seconds West, leaving the northerly line of said Urton tract, passing Iron Pins found at 410.43 feet and 591.65 feet, an Iron Pipe set at 955.13 feet, Iron Pins found at 1495.13 feet and 1758.40 feet, a total distance of 2,022.72 feet to an Iron Pipe set at the northeasterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to Martha E. McQuirt by deed of record in Vol. 289, Page 727 (Madison County);

thence North 56 degrees 48 minutes 46 seconds East, passing an Iron Pipe set at 421.28 feet, an Iron Pin found at 922.05 feet, and an Iron Pipe set at 1356.77 feet, a total distance of 1856.77 feet to an Iron Pipe set;

thence North 57 degrees 25 minutes 11 seconds East, a distance of 334.44 feet to an Iron Pin found at the southeasterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to Edna L. Love by deed of record in Official Record Book 55, Page 94 (Madison County) and the southwesterly corner of a tract of land conveyed to Central Ohio Anglers and Hunters Club by deed of record in Deed Book 127, Page 161 (Madison County);

thence North 55 degrees 35 minutes 12 seconds East, leaving the aforementioned property corner, a distance of 165.62 feet to an Iron Pipe set;

thence/66 degrees 48 minutes 46 seconds, a distance of 500.00 feet to Franklin County Engineers Monument WE48;

thence North 56 degrees 54 minutes 56 seconds East, passing an Iron Pipe set at 296.20 feet and an Iron Pin found at 544.27 feet, a total distance of 796.20 feet to the True Point of Beginning.

Containing 305.390 acres. Of the 305.390 acres, 175.110 acres, more or less, are contained within Auditor's Parcel Number 230-002969, Franklin County, Ohio and 130.280 acres, more or less, are contained within Auditor's Parcels Number 08-00929.000, Madison County, Ohio.

Subject to all applicable easements, conditions, restrictions and rights-of-way of record.

Bearings are based on the State Plane Coordinates, Ohio South Zone, NAD 83, using the Franklin County Geodetic Survey Monuments WE34 and WE52.

All Iron Pipes set are "" I.D. hollow steel pipe, 30" long, with a plastic cap stamped 'CEC, INC.

All references herein are to records in the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, unless otherwise stated.
