

## 2.9929 Acre Tract Surveyed for John Gingerich

The following described 2.9929 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Canaan Township, VMS 10982, and being part of a 44.2113 acre tract conveyed to Erma Lou and John L. Gingerich, joint lives, by deed book 296 page 283, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Lafayette-Plain City Road (County Road #5)(50 ft. right-of-way) said railroad spike being the southeast corner of a 40.9493 acre tract conveyed to Willis and Mabel Sommers by deed book 218 page 376;

Thence, North 02° 18 minutes 01 seconds West, passing a PK nail found at the southeast corner of a 1.4467 acre tract conveyed to John R. and Rosanne J. Shenk by official record 107 page 2287 at 1.24 ft., also passing a 3/4 inch diameter thin wall electrical conduit and yellow plastic caps stamped "R. I. Baker 5539" found at 34.60 ft., also passing a 3/4 inch diameter thin wall electrical conduit and yellow plastic caps stamped "R. I. Baker 5539" found 0.3 ft. East of the north east corner of said 1.4467 acre tract at 446.50 ft., also passing an iron pin and cap set at 597.75 ft. a total distance of 618.54 ft. to a point in the centerline of an open ditch;

Thence, with the centerline of said opened ditch and a new line across said 44.2113 acre tract, North 39° 02 minutes 46 seconds East a distance a 100.00 feet;

Thence, continuing with a new line across said 44.2113 acre tract, South 48° 02 minutes 07 seconds East, passing an iron pin and cap at 378.16 ft., a total distance of 405.07 ft. to a concrete nail and washer set in the centerline of Lafayette-Plain City Road;

Thence, with said centerline, South 38° 37 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 543.75 ft. returning to the point beginning containing 2.9929 acres more or less.

Bearings are based on the centerline of Lafayette-Plain City Road (South 38° 37 minutes West) as described in deed book 296 page 283.

This deed is subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic caps stamped "Cottrill 6858."
