

## 0.1844 Acre Tract Surveyed for Kevin Pullin (Tract one)

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Val Wilson Road (Township Road #108)(33 ft. right-of-way) said railroad spike also the southernmost corner of a 24.998 acre tract conveyed to Kevin L. and Alice L. Pullin by official record 127 page 2608, and the westernmost corner of a 5.002 acre tract conveyed to Peter A. and Leta L. Gunnell by official record 112 page 573;

Thence, with the line between said 24.998 and said 5.002 acre tracts, North 51° 20 minutes 17 seconds East, passing a 5/8 inch diameter rebar and yellow plastic cap stamped "Fox 7000" found at 25.00 ft., also passing an iron pin and cap set at 674.38 ft., also passing a one half inch diameter iron pipe found at 706.22 ft. a total distance of 730.04 ft. to a 5/8 inch diameter rebar and yellow plastic caps stamped "Fox 7000" found in the southwestern line of said 20.014 acre tract also been the true point beginning;

Thence, across said 20.014 acre tract the following 3 new courses:

- 1) North 51° 20 minutes 17 seconds East a distance of 39.08 ft. to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 40° 35 minutes 56 seconds East a distance of 205.68 ft. to an iron pin and cap set
- 3) South 51° 20 minutes 17 seconds West a distance of 39.08 ft. to an iron pin and cap set in the northeast line of said 5.002 acre tract

Thence, with the northeast line of said 5.002 acre tract, North 40° 35 minutes 56 seconds West a distance of 205.68 ft. returning to the true point beginning containing 0.1844 acres more or less.

The hereinabove described 0.1844 acre tract is to become part of and contingent to Gunnell's 5.002 acre tract.

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Val Wilson Road (Township Road #108)(33 ft. right-of-way) said railroad spike also the southernmost corner of a 24.998 acre tract conveyed to Kevin L. and Alice L. Pullin by official record 127 page 2608, and the westernmost corner of said 5.002 acre tract;

Thence, with the line between said 24.998 and said 5.002 acre tracts, North 51° 20 minutes 17 seconds East, passing a 5/8 inch diameter rebar and yellow plastic cap stamped "Fox 7000" found at 25.00 ft., also passing an iron pin and cap set at 674.38 ft., a total distance of 706.22 ft. to a one half inch diameter iron pipe found corner to said 5.002 and said 24.998 acre tracts, also been the true point beginning;

Thence, with the line between said 24.998 and said 5.002 acre tracts the following 2 courses:

- 1) North 37° 56 minutes 37 seconds West a distance of 322.68 ft. to a 5/8 inch diameter rebar and yellow plastic cap stamped "Fox 7000" found
- 2) North 50° 27 minutes 58 seconds East a distance of 25.95 ft. to a. 5/8 inch diameter rebar and yellow plastic cap stamped "Fox 7000" found at the westernmost corner of a 20.014 acre tract conveyed to Kevin L. and Alice L. Pullin by official record 127 page 2608

Thence, with the centerline of said Val Wilson Road the following two courses:

- 1) North 38° 53 minutes 15 seconds West a distance of 117.30 ft. to a PK nail found
- 2) North 39° 00 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 172.31 ft. to a mag nail set in said centerline

Thence, across said 24.998 acre tract the following two new courses:

- 1) North 51° 20 minutes 17 seconds East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 20.00 ft., a total distance of 679.49 ft. to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 37° 56 minutes 37 seconds East a distance of 289.62 ft. to an iron pin and cap set in the northwest line of said 5.002 acre tract
