

The following description is for a parcel of land in the state of Ohio, County of Madison, City of London, V.M.S. 9471 and is all of a 0.15 acre tract known as First Tract and all that remains of a 0.15 acre tract known as Second Tract in Deed Book 153, page 175 and recorded in the name of James T. Stortz Life Estate, said parcel being more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a a T-bar found in the easterly line of school Street and the southerly line of a 8 feet alley, said bar also being the northwesterly corner of the abovementioned First Tract, thence with said southerly line N 69°49'00" E 130.38 feet to a found T-bar at the northwesterly corner of a 0.11 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 288, page 286 in the name of Elwood and Myrtle Guthrie;

Thence, with the line between the aforementioned Stortz and Guthrie, S 23°37'25" E 61.02 feet to a T-bar found, said T-bar being the southwesterly corner of said Guthrie and in the northerly line of 0.13 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 147, page 628, in the name of Ruth Potter;

Thence S 67°31'55" W, passing the northwesterly corner of said 0.13 tract and the northeasterly corner of a 0.14 acre tract recorded in Deed Book 282, page 630 in the name of Michael and Robin Morris at 22.90 feet, a total distance of 125.58 feet to a found 1" iron pipe in the easterly line of School Street;

Thence, with said easterly line, N 27°35'00" W 66.47 feet to the point of beginning.
