

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Village of Mt. Sterling, being a part of Virginia Military Survey No. 12140, containing 0.1665 acre of land, more or less, being all of the residue of that 130 pole tract of land as described in a deed to the Federal National Mortgage Association of record in Official Record 233, Page 26 (all references to official records in this description refer to the records of the Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio), said 0.1665 acre tract of land being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning, for reference, at a P.K. nail (found) at the centerline intersection of Yankeetown Street (State Route 207) and Clevenger Avenue; thence S 10 deg. 30' 51" W, with the centerline of said Yankeetown Street, a portion of the easterly line of said original 130 pole tract, a distance of 296.72 feet to a point at the southeasterly corner of said original 130 pole tract as originally described in Deed Book 121, Page 433, being the true point of beginning;
