

## SURVEY FOR CHARLES HART 35.209 ACRES

April 22, 2007

The following described 35.209 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Somerford, V.M.S. 5198 and 12916, being part of a remainder of Charles E. Hart's original 501.65 acre tract described in Deed Volume 279, page 720, and said 35.209 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a 1 inch iron pin found in a monument box at the intersection of the centerline of Arbuckle Road (40 feet wide) with the centerline of State Route #187 (60 feet wide);

Thence South 42°57'20" East (assumed bearing) 504.11 feet, following the centerline of Arbuckle Road, to a railroad spike found at a southwest corner of John W. and Laura A. Hardesty's 35.001 acre tract described in Official Record 169, page 682 (35.001 acre tract formerly part of said original 501.65 acre tract);

Thence South 42°06'00" East 198.95 feet, following the centerline of said Road, the southwest line of said 35.001 acre tract, and the southwest line of John W. Hardesty Jr. and Laura A. Hardesty's 33.008 acre tract described in Official Record 202, page 97 (33.008 acre tract formerly part of said original 501.65 acre tract), to a ¾ inch iron pipe found;

Thence South 42°05'06" East 463.58 feet, following the centerline of said Road and the southwest line of said 33.008 acre tract, to a magnetic nail found at a west corner of a remainder of said original 501.65 acre tract, said magnetic nail marking the place of beginning;

Thence North 47°54'54" East 266.45 feet, departing from the centerline of said Road, following a southeast line of said 33.008 acre tract and a northwest line of a remainder of said original 501.65 acre tract, passing at 20.00 feet a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "CLAPSADDLE RS #6140", to a 5/8 inch iron pin found with cap marked "CLAPSADDLE RS #6140";

Thence North 42°05'06" West 143.31 feet, following a northeast line of said 33.008 acre tract and a southwest line of a remainder of said original 501.65 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 52°58'56" East 4264.03 feet, crossing a remainder of said original 501.65 acre tract, passing at approximately 169 feet the east line of V.M.S. 12916 and thereafter crossing V.M.S. 5198, to an iron pin set in the west line of Lynne Staley, Todd Staley, Gregory Sowder, Timothy Sowder, Randall Sowder, Jennifer Weislogel, and Steven Weislogel's, (1/8 interest each) 80.65 acre Third Tract described in Deed Volume 278, page 650, and Gregory Sowder's (1/8 interest) 80.65 acre Third Tract described in Official Record 110, page 1962, and in the southwest line of V.M.S. 9838 and 10619;

Thence South 36°04'05" East 349.04 feet, following a northeast line of said original 501.65 acre tract, a southwest line of said 80.65 acre tract, the northeast line of V.M.S. 5198, and the southwest line of V.M.S. 9838 and 10619, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 52°58'56" West 4494.79 feet, entering V.M.S. 5198 and crossing said original 501.65 acre tract, passing at approximately 4187 feet the west line of V.M.S. 5198 and thereafter entering V.M.S. 12916, passing at 4474.71 feet an iron pin set, to a magnetic nail set in the centerline of Arbuckle Road and in a southwest line of said original 501.65 acre tract;

Thence North 42°05'06" West 183.42 feet, following the centerline of Arbuckle Road and a southwest line of said original 501.65 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 35.209 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 35.209 acre tract, 33.178 acres are within V.M.S. 5198 and 2.031 acres are within V.M.S. 12916.

Thence South 36°04'05" East 180.12 feet, following a northeast line of said original 501.65 acre tract, the northeast line of V.M.S. 5198, a southwest line of said 80.65 acre tract, and the southwest line of V.M.S. 9838 and 10619, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 52°58'56" West 4264.03 feet, entering V.M.S. 5198 and crossing a remainder of said original 501.65 acre tract, passing at approximately 4095 feet the west line of V.M.S. 5198, thereafter entering V.M.S. 12916, to the place of beginning, containing 32.952 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.
