

## 20.020 Acres Remainder

Description of a 20.020 acre remainder of two existing tracts owned by Delmar W. and Verna R. Headings, with the first tract being 48.718 acres, O.R. 268, Pg. 824 (Tract A1) and the second tract being 1.5619 acres, O.R. 31, Pg. 656 (F), as surveyed in April, 2007, with said remainder being located within VMS 7398 and VMS 7823, County of Madison, State of Ohio, and fronting Amity Pike (County Road #36), with said remainder bounded and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing from a monument assembly box in the middle of U.S. Route #42 (London-Delaware Road) and the projected centerline of Amity Pike (County Road #36, 50 feet wide right-of-way width), thence following the centerline tangents of Amity Pike, easterly 4,132.50 feet to a steel pin, thence S 45 deg. 41' 30" E - 306.44 feet to a railroad spike, with said spike also being the True Point of Beginning;

Thence following the centerline thereof N 45 deg. 41' 30" W, a distance of 60.00 feet to a pk nail set, said pk nail also being the southeasterly corner of 1.2784 acre tract owned by Delmar W. and Verna R. Headings recorded in O.R.285, Pg. 865;

Thence, continuing along said 1.2784 acre tract, N 44 deg. 18' 30" E, a distance of 137.43 feet to an iron pipe found, passing an iron pipe set at 25';

Thence, continuing along said 1.2784 acre tract, N 13 deg. 57' 20" E, a distance of 265.19 feet to an iron pipe found;

Thence, continuing along said 1.2784 acre tract, N 76 deg. 02' 40" W, a distance of 141.02 feet to a point, said point being the northwesterly corner of said 1.2784 acre tract and the westerly line of a 30.662 acre tract owned by Marynell Graber recorded in O.R. 282, Pg. 127 and being 0.66' easterly of and iron pipe found;

Thence, along the westerly line of said 30.662 acre tract, N 13 deg. 57' 20" E, (passing into Darby Civil Township) a distance of 1,929.88 feet to a T post found, said T post found also being the northeasterly corner of a 101.879 acre tract owned by Andrew B. Mayer recorded in O.R. 282, Pg. 132 and also being the northerly boundary of the combined VMS 7398 & 7823;

Thence S 86 deg. 03' 18" E, a distance of 466.75 feet to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set, said iron pin set is on the southerly line of a 118.859 acre tract owned by Burl J. Mayer, Trustee of the Burl J. Mayer Trust recorded in O.R. 72, Pg. 1080;

Thence, S 13 deg. 57' 20" W, (passing into Canaan Civil Township) a distance of 1,370.13 feet to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set;

Thence, N 78 deg. 01' 32" W, a distance of 99.20 feet to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set;

Thence, S 13 deg. 57' 20" W, a distance of 200.97 feet to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set;

Thence, S 22 deg. 01' 25" W, a distance of 593.78 feet passing through a 1.5691 acre tract owned by Delmar W. and Verna R. Headings recorded in O.R. 31, Pg. 656, to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set;

Thence, continuing through said 1.5691 acre tract, S 44 deg. 18' 30" W, a distance of 304.41 feet along the westerly line of a 0.0357 acre tract owned by Delmar W. and Verna R. Headings recorded in O.R. 31, Pg. 658 and the westerly line of a 25.074 acre tract owned by Delmar W. and Verna R. Headings recorded in O.R. 214, Pg. 291 (passing a 3/4 inch pipe at 32.74 feet and a 3/4 inch capped R.I. Baker, S 5539 iron pipe found at 63.74 feet) to the True Point of Beginning.

Containing 20.020 acres remainder of the said (A1) 48.718 acre tract and said (F) 1.5619 acre tract of which 7.481 acres are in Darby Civil Township and 12.539 acres are in Canaan Civil Township, Madison County, Ohio and being subject to all easements, legal highways, zoning and to all conditions and descriptions of record, including a 20 feet wide drainage easement as shown on the attached plat of survey, made a part of this description y this reference. - 4) thence S 87 deg. 47' 45" W, a distance of 302.39 feet to a point;
- 5) thence N 77 deg. 47' 10" W, a distance of 137.96 feet to a point:

Thence, continuing through said 1.591 acre tract, S 22 deg. 01' 25" W, a distance of 566.52 feet (passing a 3/4 inch capped R.I. Baker, S 5539 iron pipe at 532.70 feet) to a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set;

Thence, continuing through said 1.591 acre tract, said 25.074 acre tract and 0.0357 acre tract, S 44 deg. 18' 30" W, a distance of 316.23 feet (passing a 3/4 inch capped iron pipe set at 291.14 feet) to a P.K. nail set at the centerline of Amity Pike;

Thence along the centerline of Amity Pike, N 45 deg. 41' 10" W, a distance of 60.00 feet to the True Point of Beginning.
