

Property boundary description of 4.183 acres of land located at 6651 Lafayette-Plain City Road (Co. Rd. # 5) in VMS 7791 in Canaan Civil Township, Madison County, Ohio and is a portion of reported 16.8484 acres carried as permanent parcel number 01-00563.000 (aerial Parcel # 271) being shown in D.8. 259 at Pg. 0088 with title being Menno Hostetler and Amanda Hostetler, said 4.183 acres being bounded and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning with a buried railroad spike in the junction of A.W. Wilson Road and Lafayette-Plain City Road...

Thence: With the centerline of A.W.Wilson Road (Co. Rd.# 31) S 52 deg 58 min 51 sec E 304.690 feet to a buried railroad spike found;

Thence: Following a wire fence (passing a wood post at 26.075 feet) S 42 deg 56 min 29 sec W 289.550 feet to an existing wood post and angle in said fence line;

Thence: Continue with said wire fence S 49 deg O2 min 22 sec W 339.210 feet to a set rebar (capped) at the outside base of a wood corner post;

Thence: Again with said wire fence (passing a set capped rebar and wood end post at 285.110 feet) N 35 deg 40 min 47 sec W 311.029 feet to a nail in the middle of Lafayette-Plain City Road (Co. Rd. # 5);

Thence: With the center alignment of said roadway go N 47 deg 00 min 00 sec E 535.380 feet to the true point of beginning. (This last course being the basis for bearings as described `in D.B. 259 at Pg. 0088).

Containing within said bounds 4.183 acres. Rebars set are capped and stamped R.I.Baker S-5539.

This description is based on a current field survey made by Rodger I. Baker, Ohio surveyor # S-005539)

Also the following described 40 feet wide drainage easement to benefit the Grantees. This easement runs parallel with Lafayette-Plain City Road and is 40 feet in width abutting the Easterly right of way line of said roadway.

Commence with a found buried railroad spike in the junction of A.W.Wilson Road and Lafayette-Plain City Road. go then along the middle of Lafayette-Plain City Road S 47 deg 00 min 00 sec W 535.380 feet to the westerly corner of the herein described 4.183 acres; then with the southwesterly bounday therewith and passing a set rebar and existing wood post at 25.919 feet go S 35 deg 40 min 47 sec E 45.370 feet to the beginning of this easement at the middle thereof;

Thence: With the centerline of said 40 feet wide drainage easement go S 47 deg 00 min 00 sec W 1003.50 feet to a subsurface tile main line known as Bridgeman Ditch tile line # 29-A which point is were this easement is to terminate. (At this location there is an existing concrete box inlet with a steel lid at the roadside ditch and a concrete pipe culvert crossing beneath the roadway).
