

30.969 ACRES

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of U.S. Route 42 at the northeasterly corner of the New Par 0.8430 acre tract, of record in Official Record 48, Page 358, said spike also being located North 42° 53' 26" East, a distance of 200.00 feet from a railroad spike found at the intersection of said centerline with the westerly line of Virginia Military Survey Number 6647, the easterly line of Virginia Military Survey Numbers 12142 and 12153;

thence North 42° 53' 26" East, with the centerline of U.S. Route 42, a distance of 866.64 feet to a railroad spike found;

thence South 47° 06' 34" East, passing an iron pin found in the southerly right-of-way line of U.S. Route 42 at a corner of the Paul J. Flucke, Trustee 189.073 acre tract (of record in Official Record 124, Page 1197) at 30.00 feet, a total distance of 1000.00 feet to an iron pin found at a corner of said Flucke 189.073 acre tract;

thence South 42° 53' 26" West, with a northerly line of said Paul J. Flucke, Trustee 189.073 acre tract, a distance of 1704.92 feet to an iron pin found at a corner of said tract and being in the easterly line of Virginia Military Survey Numbers 12142 and 12153, the easterly line of the George L. McMurray 60 acre tract (Third Tract), of record in Deed Book 143, Page 308;

thence North 14° 33' 37" West, with said Virginia Military Survey line and easterly line of the George L. McMurray 60 acre tract, a distance of 968.34 feet to an iron pin found at the southwesterly corner of the New Par 0.8430 acre tract;

thence North 42° 53' 26" East, with the southerly line of said New Par 0.8430 acre tract, a distance of 200.00 feet to an iron pin found at the southeasterly corner of said tract;

thence North 14° 33' 37" West, with the easterly line of the New Par 0.8430 acre tract (passing an iron pin found in the southerly right-of-way line of U.S. Route 42 at 182.36 feet), a distance of 218.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 30.969 acres, more or less.
