

2.0066 Acre Tract Surveyed for Tom Hudson

Commencing at a railroad spike set over an iron pin found at the centerline intersection of Selsor-Moon Road (County Road 16)(50 ft. right-of-way) with Pancake-Selsor Road (Township Road 90)(50 ft. right-of-way), said spike is also at the southeast corner of said 10.9481 acre tract;

Thence, with the centerline of said Selsor-Moon Road, North 84° 26 minutes 18 seconds West a distance of 453.03 ft. to a mag nail set in said centerline at **The True Point of Beginning**;

Thence, continuing with the centerline of said Selsor-Moon Road, North 84° 26 minutes 18 seconds West a distance of 250.00 ft. to a mag nail previously set at the southeast corner of a 65.0519 acre tract conveyed to Clarence T. and Linda J. Hudson by official record 231 page 1877;

Thence, with an east line of said 65.0519 acre tract, North 08° 12 minutes 13 seconds East, passing an iron pin and cap previously set at 23.00 ft., a total distance of 350.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap set;

Thence, across said 10.9481 acre tract the following 2 new courses:

- 1) South 84° 26 minutes 18 seconds East a distance of 250.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap
- 2) South 08° 12 minutes 11 seconds West, passing an iron pin and cap set at 324.59 ft., a total distance of 350.00 ft. returning to **The True Point Beginning** containing **2.0066 Acres** more or less.

Bearings are based on a GPS observation all on April 20, 2007, WGS 1984 geodetic north.

Thence, with the centerline of said Selsor-Moon Road, North 84° 26 minutes 18 seconds West a distance of 453.03 ft. to a mag nail set in said centerline;

Thence, across said 10.9481 acre tract the following 2 new courses:

- 1) North 08° 12 minutes 11 seconds East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 25.41 ft., a total distance of 350.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) North 84° 26 minutes 18 seconds West a distance of 250.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap set in an east line of a 65.0519 acre tract conveyed to Clarence T. and Linda J. Hudson by Official Record 231 page 1877

Thence, with said 65.0519 acre tract the following 2 courses:

- 1) North 08° 12 minutes 13 seconds East a distance of 371.25 ft. to an iron pin and cap previously set
- 2) South 82° 42 minutes 20 seconds East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 646.43 ft., a total distance of 666.15 ft. to a mag nail set in the centerline of said Pancake-Selsor Road

Thence, with the centerline of said Pancake-Selsor Road, South 05° 14 minutes 19 seconds West a distance of 700.35 ft. returning to the point beginning containing 9.1592 Acres more or less.
