

Description of 3.991 acres of land being split out of 61.43 acres cited as being second tract in D.B. 297 Pg. 300 said tract two now carried as tax parcel 01-00225.000, aerial parcel # 236, currently owned by Ervin 3. Hostetler and Susan Hostetler being in VMS 8540 in Canaan Civil Township, Madison County, Ohio...said 3.991 acres is bounded and more particularly described as follows:

Commence for a starting reference with a found steel pin in the junction of Killbury Road and Price Hilliard Road (both roads being 50 feet in right of way width)...go then with the middle of Killbury Road northerly 3231.145 feet to a found buried spike at the true point of beginning at the southwesterly corner of of aforementioned 61.43 acres cited as being tract two, said spike also the northwesterly corner of 60.76 acres 0.R. 78 Pg. 538 P.P.N. 01-00219.000 aerial parcel # 230 also belonging to Ervin Jay Hostetler and Susan Hostetler, and this point of beginning point measures 962.140 feet northerly from a found spike at the southwest corner of said 60.76 acres;

Thence: From the point of beginning go along the middle of Killbury Road N 07 deg 30 min 00 sec W 298.745 feet to a set spike which measures 1474.805 feet S 07 deg 30 min 00 sec E from a steel pin found at a P.I. point of Killbury Road;

Thence: Passing a set rebar at 16.60 feet go S 86 deg 43 min 45 sec E 619.530 feet to a capped rebar set;

Thence: S 03 deg 23 min 24 sec W 294.650 feet to a capped steel rod set on the southerly boundary of tract two cited herein;

Thence: Passing a capped rebar set at 545.785 feet, go N 86 deg 36 min 36 sec W 563.085 feet along the southerly boundary of tract two to the true point of beginning. (This course being the basis for bearings ).

Rebars and steel rods set are capped and stamped R.I.Baker S-5539.

Bearings based on 0 R 78 Pg. 538 and D.B. 297 Pg. 300.

Also the following right to tap into an existing 8 inch drain line.

Grantees are hereby granted an easement for subsurface drainage by tapping into and connecting their own private subsurface drain tile or pipe into an existing 8 inch diameter drainage line which tile or pipe line runs nearly parallel with the northerly boundary of the herein described 3.991 acres with the evidence of this alinement being approximately 15 feet northerly of this northerly boundary of 3.991 acres with said alignment being located possibly as close as 5 feet offset from the northeasterly corner of the herein surveyed 3.991 acres.
