Thence, with the east line of said High Street, South 39° 45 minutes 30 seconds East a distance of 82.08 ft. to an iron pin and cap set at **The True Point Beginning**;

Thence, with a new line across said Lot 2, North 50° 17 minutes 39 seconds East a distance of 66.00 ft. to a point in the west line of Lot 1 of said Original Town;

Thence, with the west line of said Lot 1, South 39° 45 minutes 30 seconds East a distance of 50.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap set in the north line of a 16.5 ft. alley;

Thence, with the north line of said 16.5 ft. alley, South 50° 17 minutes 39 seconds West a distance of 66.00 ft. to an iron pin and cap set at the intersection of the north line of said 16.5 ft. alley and the east line of said High Street;

Thence, with the east line of said High Street, North 39° 45 minutes 30 seconds West a distance of 50.00 ft. returning to **The True Point Beginning** containing **0.0758 Acres** more or less.
