DESCRIPTION OF A 3.172 ACRE TRACT SPLIT FROM A 15.005 ACRE PARCEL IN THE NAME OF

LEONARD G. & TERESA A. HORSTMAN

in Virginia Military Survey 2677 AND 8641 Jefferson Township, Madison County, Ohio

This description is for a 3.172 acre tract split form a 15.005 acre property in the name of Leonard G. and Teresa A. Horstman, (Official Records 54, Page 545, Madison County Recorder, Auditor's Parcel #08-00023.000) located on the west side of Plain City-Georgesville Road (County Road 7, 50 foot Right-of-way), approximately 2100 feet south of U. S. 40 along the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, in V.M.S. 2677 and V.M.S. 8641, Jefferson Township, Madison County, Ohio and is further described as follows:

COMMENCING at an iron pin found at the northeast corner of the said 15.005 acre property in the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, said pin is 1716.8 feet, plus or minus, from the centerline of the eastbound lane of U.S. 40, measured along the surveyed centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, and is located at the southeast corner of a property in the name of James L. and Megan E. West (O.R. 233, Pg. 1909);

Thence S14°01'55'E, 318.92 feet, along the centerline of said Plain City-Georgesville Road to a MAG Nail set at the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence S14°01'55"E, 293.39 feet, continuing along the centerline of said road to a MAG Nail set at a Point of Intersection of the said road, said MAG Nail is referenced by an iron pin set in the west Right-of-way of said road at S80°44'26"W, 25.09 feet;

Thence S04°29'25"E, 222.39 feet, along the centerline of said road to a MAG Nail set at the southeast corner of the said Horstman property;

Thence S75°56'22"W, 291.00 feet, passing an iron pin set at 25.35 feet, and passing form V.M.S. 2677 into V.M.S. 8641 at 145.90 feet, along the north line of a property in the name of Robert Scott and Connie C. Murray (Deed Book 280, Page 763) to an iron pin set;

Thence N09°23'20"W, 407.82 feet, into the said Horstman Tract, passing into V.M.S. 2677 at 352.54 feet, to an iron pin set;

Thence N56°07'51"E, 313.45 feet, passing an iron pin set in the west Right-of-way of the said Plain City-Georgesville Road at 286.87 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Said tract contains 3.172 acres, of which 2.587 acres is in V.M.S. 2677 and 0.585 acres is within V.M.S. 8641, and is subject to all easements and rights-of-way of record. The remainder left from the 15.005 acre property is 11.833 acres, of which 2.666 acres is within V.M.S. 2677 and 9.167 acres is within V.M.S. 8641. The BASIS OF BEARINGS is S56°08'07"W along the southeast lines of Lots 69 and 70 of the Hidden Creek at the Darby, Phase Four East plat (Plat Book 2, Slide 283-287. All monuments set are 5/8 inch diameter steel rebar with plastic identification caps labeled ELLIOTT PS7759. This description is based on a survey performed in December 2009 by Casey Elliott, PS7759 State of Ohio. This survey and description meet the MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR BOUNDARY SURVEYS IN OHIO, as described in Chapter 4733-37 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
