LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Sunny Field, LLC 396.867 Acres Tract

Situated in the Township of Deercreek, County of Madison, State of Ohio, being a part of V.M.S. Nos. 7560, 12067-12167, and 12142-12153, being all (310.872 acres) of the 309.06 acres "Tract One" and all (85.995 acres) of the 86.51 acres "Tract Two" as conveyed to Sunny Field, LLC and recorded in Official Record 235, Page 261 of the Madison County Recorder's Office, and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a Mag nail (set) marking the centerline of State Route 38 and Dun Road (Township Road No. 114) and marking the northwesterly corner of the 309.06 acres "Tract One" as conveyed to Sunny Field, LLC (O.R. 235, Page 261);

thence with the centerline of Dun Road S 83°50'27" E, a distance of 4102.02 feet to a railroad spike (found), said railroad spike being the northwesterly corner of the 86.50 acres "Parcel III" as conveyed to The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus (D.B. 280, Page 720);

thence with the westerly line of The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus S 06°58'02" W, passing a 5/8" iron pin (set) by a wood post (10 inches in diameter), a total distance of 2967.08 feet to a 4" x 7" stone (found) with a cross notch by a post in the northerly line of the 171.88 acres "Parcel IV, Tract One" as conveyed to The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus (D.B. 280, Page 720);

thence with the northerly line of The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus S $87^{\circ}18'27"$ W, a distance of 417.78 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (set) by a steel post (found);

thence also with the northerly line of The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus S 82°22'12" W, a distance of 832.88 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (set);

thence with the westerly line of The Roman Catholic Bishop of The Diocese of Columbus S 07°06'22" W, passing a 4" metal post (found) at 168.98 feet, a total distance of 879.33 feet to a 6" x 6" stone monument (found) in the northerly line of the 1122.116 acres tract as conveyed to The Board of Trustees of The Ohio State University (D.B. 289, Page 158);

thence with the northerly line of The Board of Trustees of The Ohio State University N 78°38'35" W, passing a 6" x 6" stone monument (found) at 3851.29 feet, a total distance of 3880.94 feet to a railroad spike (found) in the centerline of State Route 38;

thence with the centerline of State Route 38 N 20°45'14" E, a distance of 1427.68 feet to a railroad spike (found) under the pavement;

thence also with the centerline of State Route 38 N 19°22'38" E, a distance of 1890.72 feet to a Mag nail (set);

thence continuing with the centerline of State Route 38 N 31°06'54" E, a distance of 590.05 feet to the beginning, containing 396.867 acres of land.

Subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.

Bearings are based upon the Grid Azimuth (AZ. 411° 53' 07.6") between National Geodetic Survey Monument "LONDON AZ MK" and McCarty Associates Geodetic Survey Monument "SUNNYFIELD (2001)"

and derived from GPS observations taken February 23, 2010, utilizing the Trimble ODOT CORS VRS (Virtual Reference System).

Land surveyed in February 2010, under the direction of Thomas E. Purtell, Registered Professional Surveyor No. 6519, the survey plat of which is referred to as Project No. S10-753 on file in the office of McCarty Associates, LLC, Washington C.H., Ohio.

All iron pins (set) are 5/8" diameter with 1-1/4" diameter plastic caps stamped "McCARTY ASSOCIATES".
