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DESCRIPTION OF A 0.560 ACRE TRACT

Situated in the Village of Lilly Chapel, Township of Fairfield, County of Madison, State of Ohio, located in VMS #5280, being 0.560 acres out of that 4.35 acre tract of land conveyed to S & S Investments in O.R. 242, Page 2672, said 0.560 acres being more particularly described as:

Commencing for reference at a point marking the intersection of the centerline of Lilly Chapel-Georgesville Road (County Road 102) and the centerline of West Jefferson-Kiousville Road;

Thence, South 84° 53' 48" East, with the centerline of said Lilly Chapel-Georgesville Road, a distance of 970.36 feet to the southwesterly corner of said 4.35 acres, said point also being the southeasterly corner of that 0.59 acre tract conveyed to Ray D. & Judith E. Johnson in O.R. 203, Page 231;

Thence, North 04° 18' 08" East, with a westerly line of said 4.35 acres and with the easterly line of said 0.59 acres, a distance of 156.52 feet to a 3/4-inch iron pin with cap ("Cottrill") found at the northeasterly corner of said 0.59 acres, the same being the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence, from said TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING, North 85° 12' 20" West, with a southerly line of said 4.35 acres and with the northerly line of said 0.59 acres, a distance of 122.07 feet to a 5/8-inch rebar with cap ("S-7980") found at a southwesterly corner of said 4.35 acres, the same being in the northerly line of said 0.59 acres and being a southerly corner of that 4.6437 acre tract conveyed to Raymond Elwood Cotton in O.R. 240, Page 145;

Thence, North 02° 12' 32" East, with a westerly line of said 4.35 acres and with an easterly line of said 4.6437 acres, a distance of 200.00 feet to a rebar set;

Thence, South 85° 12' 36" East, crossing a portion of said 4.35 acres, a distance of 122.31 feet to a rebar set;

Thence, South 02° 16' 34" West, crossing a portion of said 4.35 acres, a distance of 200.00 feet to the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Page Two (0.560 ac.)

Containing 0.560 acres of land (by Survey).

Subject to all easements, restrictions and rights-of-way of record.

All rebar's set are 5/8-inch in diameter and 30-inches long with a cap bearing the inscription "S-7980".

Bearings are based on North 02° 04' 46" East, as given for the easterly line of that 0.5723 acre tract conveyed in O.R. 137, Page 448.
