L. and S. railroad right-of-way) said an iron pin and cap is the northwest corner of said 34.8432 acre tract and the north east corner of a laneway leading to a 43.7579 acre tract conveyed to Kirk K. Miller, Et al by Official Record 232 page 1935, said an iron pin and cap is 75 ft. right of the centerline of the westbound lane of US 40 station 198+ 79.12 as shown on the ODOT right-of-way plans Madison County, S.H.1 SEC.
