LEGAL DESCRIPTION

David L. Katterhenrich, et al And Amber T. Bigam, et al 39.897 Acres Tract

Situated in the Township of Fairfield, County of Madison, State of Ohio, being a part of V.M.S. No. 6260, being all that remains of the original 41, acres, 30 poles as conveyed to Amber T. Bigam and Apryl T. Flocken (one half interest) and recorded in Official Record 191, Page 1161, and one half interest conveyed to David L. Katterhenrich (50% interest), Alice Katterhenrich (12.50% interest), Beth Ann Katterhenrich (12.50% interest), David J. Katterhenrich (12.50% interest), and Laura Scheck (12.50% interest) and recorded in Official Record 249, Page 2596 of the Madison County Recorder's Office, and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike (set) over an iron pin (found) under the pavement marking the centerline intersection of Big Plain-Circleville Road (County Road No. 4) and Kiousville-Georgesville Road (County Road No. 53);

thence with the centerline of Kiousville-Georgesville Road S 41°09'44" W, a distance of 1618.52 feet to a Mag nail (set), said Mag nail being the easterly most corner of a 12 acres tract as conveyed to William L. Webb, et al (D.B. 226, Page 499);

thence with Webb's line N $49^{\circ}15'28"$ W, passing a 5/8" iron pin (set) at 35.00 feet, a total distance of 1086.27 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (set);

thence also with Webb's line N 00°43'31" E, a distance of 280.50 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (set), said iron pin being the southeasterly corner of the 40 acres, 81 poles "Third Tract" as conveyed to Isabelle Cartmille (D.B. 167, Page 348);

thence N 01°48'36" E, a distance of 857.09 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (found), said iron pin being a corner to the 54.5 acres "First Tract" as conveyed to Isabelle Cartmille (D.B. 167, Page 348) and the westerly most corner of the 20.643 acres tract as conveyed to Steven L. Mace, et al (O.R. 250, Page 1103);

thence with Mace's southwesterly line S 44°55'41" E, a distance of 1099.01 feet to a 5/8" iron pin (found) by a corner post;

thence with Mace's southeasterly line N 42°27'01" E, a distance of 658.02 feet to a 1 %" iron pipe (found), said iron pipe being the westerly most corner of the 2.000 acres "Parcel No. One" as conveyed to Robert Dale Timmons, et ux (O.R. 071, Page 372);

thence with Timmons' southwesterly line S 32°12'25" E, a distance of 200.13 feet to a 1 4" iron pipe (found);

thence with Timmons' southeasterly line N 56°31'09" E, passing a 1" iron pipe (found) at 332.29 feet, a total distance of 356.87 feet to a nail (found) in the centerline of Big Plain - Circleville Road;

thence with the centerline of Big Plain - Circleville Road S 32°44'14" E, a distance of 431.03 feet to the beginning, containing 39.897 acres of land.

Subject to all legal easements and rights-of-way of record.

Bearings are based upon the Grid Azimuth (AZ. 357° 03' 29.0") between National Geodetic Survey Monuments "WE 1 FRA CO PIC CO MAD CO" and "FRA CO WE 20 MAD CO" and derived from GPS observations

taken November 16, 2010, utilizing the Trimble ODOT CORS VRS (Virtual Reference System).

Land surveyed in November 2010, under the direction of Thomas E. Purtell, Registered Professional Surveyor No. 6519, the survey plat of which is referred to as Project No. S10-806 on file in the office of McCarty Associates, LLC, Washington C.H., Ohio.

All iron pins (set) are 5/8" diameter with 1-1/4" diameter plastic caps stamped "McCARTY ASSOCIATES".
