
PLAT OF SURVEY



SURVEY FOR EARL OSBORNE 1.549 Acre February 2, 2011

The following described 1.549 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Canaan, V.M.S. 12746, being part of Earl W. and Susan M. Osborne's 20.500 acre tract described in Official Record 287, page 458, and said 1.549 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a brass plate in a monument box found at the southern most intersection of the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road (County Road 7, 50') with the centerline of Price-Hilliard Road (County Road 32, 45');

Thence South 06°32'17" East (assumed bearing) 379.75 feet, following the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, to a railroad spike found at a northeast corner of the remainder of Earl W. Osborne and Rebecca O. Raber's original 251.43 acre Parcel II described in Official Record 163, page 1198 (3/4 interest) and Deed Record 274, page 203 (1/4 interest), respectively, and at the southeast corner of said 20.500 acre tract;

Thence North 87°20'31" West 822.52 feet, departing from the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, following the south line of said 20.500 acre tract and a north line of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract, passing at 25.64 feet a 5/8 inch iron pin found, to an iron pin set and marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence North 87°20'31" West 418.43 feet, continuing with the south line of said 20.500 acre tract and a north line of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 02°29'41" East 161.36 feet, following a west line of said 20.500 acre tract and an east line of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract, to a ¾ inch iron pipe found at the southeast corner of Kathy M. May Trust's 8.348 acre tract described in Official Record 144, page 841;

Thence South 87°17'50" East 419.02 feet, entering said 20.500 acre tract, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 02°42'10" West 161.03 feet, continuing through said 20.500 acre tract, to the place of beginning, containing 1.549 acre, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

The above described 1.549 acre tract has no road frontage and must be transferred to an adjoining land owner that has frontage on a public road.

SURVEY FOR EARL OSBORNE 2.025 Acres, February 2, 2011

The following described 2.025 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Canaan, V.M.S. 12746, being part of Earl W. Osborne and Rebecca O. Raber's original 251.43 acre tract described in Official Record 163, page 1198 (3/4 interest) and Deed Record 274, page 203 (1/4 interest), respectively, and said 2.025 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a brass plate in a monument box found at the southern most intersection of the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road (County Road 7, 50') with the centerline of Price-Hilliard Road (County Road 32, 45');

Thence South 06°32'17" East (assumed bearing) 379.75 feet, following the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road, to a railroad spike found at a northeast corner of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract and at the southeast corner of Earl W. and Susan M. Osborne's 20.500 acre tract described in Official Record 287, page 458, said spike marking the **place of beginning**;

Thence South 06°32'17" East 107.51 feet, following the centerline of Plain City-Georgesville Road and an east line of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract, to a magnetic nail set;

Thence North 87°20'31" West 839.78 feet, departing from the centerline of Plain-City-Georgesville Road, entering the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract and passing at 25.33 feet an iron pin set, to an iron pin set;

Thence North 02°42'10" East 106.12 feet, continuing through said original 251.43 acre tract, to an iron pin set in the south line of said 20.500 acre tract;

Thence South 87°20'31" East 822.52 feet, following a north line of the remainder of said original 251.43 acre tract and the south line of said 20.500 acre tract, passing at 796.88 feet a 5/8 inch iron pin found, to the place of beginning, containing 2.025 acres, more or less, and being subject to all valid easements and restrictions of record.

Of the above described 2.025 acre tract 0.062 acre is within the right of way of Plain City-Georgesville Road.
