

The following describes 5.0001 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Range Township, VMS 5218 and 6391, being part of a 190 acre tract conveyed to Virgil D and Janice M Isaacs, Living Trust by Official Record 211 page 962, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a mag nail set over an iron pin found in the centerline of Danville Road (50 feet right-of-way) (County Road 8) at the northwest corner of said 190 acre tract and the southwest corner of a 123.856 acre tract conveyed to Virgil D and Janice M Isaacs, Living Trust by Official Record 211 page 962;

Thence, with the centerline of Said Danville Rd., South 20° 29 min. 46 seconds East a distance of 101.83 feet to a mag nail set at The True Point of Beginning;

Thence, across said 190 acre tract with the following 3 new lines:

- 1) North 69° 30′ 14" East, passing and iron pin and cap set at 26.00 feet, a total distance of 792.02 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 2) South 20° 29' 46" East a distance of 275.00 feet to an iron pin and cap set
- 3) South 69° 30' 14" West, passing and iron pin and cap set at 764.45 feet, a total distance of 792.02 feet to a mag nail set in the centerline of said Danville road,

Thence, with the centerline of Said Danville Rd., North 20° 29′ 46″ West a distance of 275.00 feet returning to The True Point of Beginning containing 5.0001 Acres more or less.

With the benefit of a 20 feet Drainage Easement across said 190 acre tract and is tangent to and 10 feet left and right of the following describe centerline: beginning at a point in the south line of the hereinabove described 5.0001 acre tract, said point bears North 69° 30′ 14″ East a distance of 393.54 feet from the southwest corner of said 5.0001 acre tract; thence, across said 190 acre tract the following two courses: 1) South 32° 31′ 07″ East a distance of 127.80 feet, 2) South 05° 49′ 56″East a distance of 230.73 feet to the southern terminus of said 20 feet drainage easement.

Bearings are bases on a GPS observation on August 28, 2013, WGS 1984 Geodetic North.

This deed is subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic caps stamped "Cottrill L.L.C. 6858."
