

DESCRIPTION OF 22.431 ACRES FROM LANDS OWNED BY RANDOLPH J. ISAACS PAINT TOWNSHIP, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO

Situate in Virginia Military Survey No. 8672, Paint Township, County of Madison, State of Ohio, and being 22.431 acres of land all out of the remainder of that 43.51 acre tract of land owned by Randolph J. Isaacs, of record in Official Record Book 97, Page 1031 (all references to records being on file in the Office of the Recorder, Madison County, Ohio), said 22.431 acre tract being further described as follows:

The True Place of Beginning being a railroad spike found in the centerline of Foody Road, at the northeast corner of said 43.51 acre tract, being the southeast corner of a 314.34 acre Tract 1, owned by Heiner Gantenbrink Farms, of record in Official Record Book 256, Page 1091, also being the southeast corner of Virginia Military Survey #8673, the northeast corner of Virginia Military Survey #8672, the northwest corner of Virginia Military Survey #9366; The Point of Reference being a railroad spike found at the centerline intersection of Foody Road with Linson Road, which bears North 03°50'52" East, passing along the easterly line of said 314.34 acre Tract 1, and a 7.11 acre Tract 3, owned by Heiner Gantenbrink Farms, of record in Official Record Volume 105, Page 562, at a distance of 3088.09 feet;

Thence from **The True Place of Beginning** South 05°32'22" West, along the centerline of said Foody Road, being the east line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, a distance of 200.15 feet to a Mag Nail set at the northeast corner of a proposed 1.629 acre parcel;

Thence North 86°25'48" West, into the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract and along the north line of said proposed 1.629 acre parcel, a distance of 346.67 feet to an iron pin set 18" deep, passing an iron pipe set at 20.01 feet;

Thence South 05°32'22" West, along the west line of said proposed 1.629 acre parcel, a distance of 208.68 feet to an iron pipe set 18" deep;

Thence South 87°41'48" East, along the south line of said proposed 1.629 acre parcel, a distance of 347.02 feet to a Mag Nail set in the centerline of Foody Road, being the east line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, and being the southwest corner of said proposed 1.629 acre parcel;

Thence South 05°32'22" West, along the centerline of said Foody Road, being the east line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, a distance of 112.53 feet to a Mag Nail set at the southeast corner of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract; being the northeast corner of a 19.40 acre tract of land owned by West Broad Street Investors LTD, of record in Official Record Book 199, Page 1374;

Thence North 87°41'48" West, along the north line of said 19.40 acre tract, being the south line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, a distance of 1919.89 feet to an iron pipe set 18" deep and being in the east line of a 62.67 acre Tract 2, owned by said Heiner Gantenbrink Farms, of record in Official Record Book 256, Page 1091, passing an iron pipe set at 25.00 feet;

Thence North 02°52'09" West, along the west line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, the east line of said 62.67 acre Tract 2, a distance of 559.34 feet to an iron pipe set 18" deep at the northeast corner of said 62.67 acre Tract 2, being the northwest corner of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, and being in the south line of said 314.34 acre Tract 1, being the south line of Virginia Military Survey No. 8673, being the north line of Virginia Military Survey No. 8672;

Thence South 86°25'48" East, along north line of the remainder of said 43.51 acre tract, being the south line of said 314.34 acre Tract 1, being the south line of Virginia Military Survey No. 8673, being the north line of Virginia Military Survey No. 8672, a distance of 1999.81 feet to **The True Place of Beginning** and containing 22.431 acre of land, passing an iron pipe set at a distance of 1974.81 feet.

For the purpose of this description, a bearing of North 03°50'52" East was used on the easterly line of that 314.34 acre Tract 1, owned by Heiner Gantenbrink Farms, of record in Official Record Volume 105, Page 562, being the centerline of a portion of Foody Road, on file in the Office of the Recorder, Madison County, Ohio, and based upon the Ohio South - State Plane Coordinate System. This description is based upon an actual field survey conducted in April of 2010, March of 2017, and November of 2018. All iron pipes set are 30 inch in length, and 3/4" I.D., with yellow plastic caps stamped "PSS 7869".
