

LEGAL DEED DESCRIPTION 2.589 Acres

Real estate situated in Pike Township of Madison County, Ohio; in the Virginia Military Survey Number 10860 and 11087; being part of the 5.158 acre tract of land owned by Norman and Marilyn Greenbaum, Trustees (Official Record 34, page 574) (Madison County Parcel Number 15-00060.000) and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a three-fourths (3/4) inch diameter iron rod found at the intersection of the centerline of Rosedale Road (County Road 25) with the centerline of Rosedale-Milford Center Road (County Road 11, 66 feet wide);

thence with said centerline of said Rosedale-Milford Center Road North 39 degrees 58 minutes 08 seconds West, 249.82 feet to a railroad spike found on the point common to the northerly line Virginia Military Survey Number 10700, the southerly line of Virginia Military Survey Number 10860 and 11087 and the most southerly corner of Greenbaum Subdivision (Plat 2-94);

thence continuing with the centerline of said Rosedale-Milford Center Road (50 feet wide) North 40 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West (reference bearing), 366.70 feet to a railroad spike found thereon:

thence North 42 degrees 49 minutes 58 seconds East, 25.20 feet to an one-half (1/2) inch diameter iron pipe found on the point common to the easterly right-of-way of said Rosedale-Milford Center Road, the southwesterly corner of Lot 2 (0.847 acres) of said Greenbaum Subdivision owned by Willard R. Mayer, Trustee (Official Record 58, page 54) and a northwesterly corner of said Greenbaum 5.158 acre tract, and point of beginning of the land to be described.

thence with the southeasterly line of said Lot 2 North 42 degrees 49 minutes 58 seconds East, 235.12 feet to an iron pipe set on the southeasterly corner thereof and on a corner of said Greenbaum 5.158 acre tract;

thence entering said Greenbaum 5.158 acre tract and making a new division thereof North 42 degrees 49 minutes 58 seconds East, 302.37 feet to an iron pipe set on the easterly line thereof and on the westerly line of a 42.96 acre tract of land owned by Norman and Marilyn Greenbaum, Trustees (Official Record 34, page 574);

thence the following five (5) consecutive courses with said Greenbaum 5.158 acre tract:

- 1. South 39 degrees 59 minutes 56 seconds East, 325.69 feet to a two (2) inch diameter steel post found on the northeasterly corner of a 0.651 acre tract of land owned by Duane L. and Erica Gingerich (Official Record 187, page 2288);
- 2. South 38 degrees 44 minutes 07 seconds West, 305.90 feet to an one-half (1/2) inch diameter iron pipe found on the point common to the southerly line of said Virginia Military Survey Number 10860 and 11087, the northwesterly line of Lot 11 of the original Village of Rosedale (formally the Village of Liverpool, Plat Book 1, page 22) being owned by Christopher M. and Amber Jones (Official Record 231, page 30) and on the southeasterly corner of Lot 4 (0.791 acres) of said Greenbaum Subdivision owned by Bethany J. Geib (Official Record 305, page 2011);
- 3. thence with the easterly line of said Lot 4 and the easterly line of Lot 3 (0.847 acres) of said Greenbaum Subdivision owned by Tyler R. Halterman (Official Record 331, page 34) North 39 degrees 59 minutes 57 seconds West, 297.34 feet to an one-half (1/2) inch diameter iron pipe found on the northeasterly corner of said Lot 3 (passing over an one-half (1/2) inch diameter iron pipe found at 139.15 feet);
- thence with the northwesterly line of said Lot 3 South 42 degrees 49 minutes 58 seconds West, 235.12 feet to an one-half (1/2) inch diameter iron pipe found on the point common to the northwesterly corner of said Lot 3 and the easterly right-of-way of said Rosedale-Milford Center Road;
- thence with the easterly right-of-way of said Rosedale-Milford Center Road North 40 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 50.38 feet to the place of beginning;

Bearing (North 40 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West) assumed from said Greenbaum Subdivision (Plat 2-94).

The tract as described from an actual field survey performed on or about March 06, 2018, by James A. Page (S-6034) of Page Engineering, Inc. of Marysville, Ohio, contains 2.589 acres, more or less, subject to all previous easements and rights-of-way of record. All iron pipes set are 3/4" x

30" galvanized pipe with yellow survey caps stamped "Page Eng. S-6034". The survey is recorded in the Map Room of the Madison County Engineer.
