

## DESCRIPTION OF A 27.668 ACRE TRACT AT 3980 NATIONAL ROAD ~ U.S. RTE. 40, DEER CREEK TOWNSHIP, MADISON CO., OHIO

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Deer Creek Township, in Virginia Military Survey Nos. 6644, 8524 & 12092 and being a 27.668 acre portion of a 29.97 acre tract of land (29.625 acres by recent survey) conveyed to Certified Real Estate, Inc., by deed of record in Official Record 217, Page 267, all records referenced to the Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a MAG Nail set in the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 (variable width), as shown upon Sheet 5 of 13 of the Ohio Department of Transportation Location Plan, Madison County, S.H. 1. SEC.-D-2(pt.) C,B & WEST JEFFERSON(pt.) and in the south line of said 29.625 acre tract, said nail being N 86° 23' 22" E a distance of 187.57 feet from a railroad spike set at the intersection of the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 with the centerline of Glade Run Road (50 feet in width);

thence N 00° 50' 48" E crossing a portion of said 29.625 acre tract and parallel with and 425 feet easterly from the west line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 200.61 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set;

thence S 86° 23° 22" W crossing a portion of said 29.625 acre tract and parallel with and 200 feet northerly from the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 and from the south line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 426.29 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set in the west line of said 29.625 acre tract and in an east line of a 541.791 acre tract of land conveyed, as Parcel Two, to Linda R. Schaefer, Successor Trustee, by deed of record in Official Record 319, Page 1987;

thence N 00° 50' 48" E along a portion of the west line of said 29.625 acre tract and along a portion of an east line of said 541.791 acre tract a distance of 1,484.61 feet to a Stone found by a wooded post at the northwest corner of said 29.625 acre tract and at a corner of said 541.791 acre tract;

thence N 87° 04' 09" E along the north line of said 29.625 acre tract and along a south line of said 541.791 acre tract a distance of 191.81 feet to a Wood Post found at a corner of said 29.625 acre tract and at a corner of said 541.791 acre tract;

thence S 70° 12' 29" E along the northeasterly line of said 29.625 acre tract and along a portion of a southwesterly line of said 541.791 acre tract a distance of 685.53 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set at the northeast corner of said 29.625 acre tract and at the northwest corner of a 4.373 acre tract of land conveyed to Rickie E. North, by deeds of record in Official Record 6, Page 46 and Official Record 298, Page 1845;

thence S 04° 28' 08" W along an east line of said 29.625 acre tract and along the west line of said 4.373 acre tract a distance of 317.66 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe found at a corner of said 29.625 acre tract, at the southwest corner of said 4.373 acre tract and at the northwest corner of a 5.3907 acre tract of land conveyed to Michael W. Merna, by deed or record in Official Record 243, Page 1658;

thence S 04° 27' 36" W along an east line of said 29.625 acre tract and along the west line of said 5.3907 acre tract a distance of 550.48 feet to a 5/8" solid iron pin found by a wooded post at a corner of said 29.625 acre tract, at the southwest corner of said 5.3907 acre tract and at the northwest corner of a 14.802 acre tract of land conveyed to William R. Horsley, Trustee, by deed or record in Official Record 241, Page 715;


thence S 06° 29' 10" E along an east line of said 29.625 acre tract and along the west line of said 14.802 acre tract a distance of 546.70 feet to a MAG nail set in the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40, at the southeast corner of said 29.625 acre tract and at the southwest corner of said 14.802 acre tract;

thence S 86° 23' 22" W along the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 and along a portion of the south line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 431.10 feet to the place of beginning;

containing 27.688 acres of land, more or less, and being subject to all highways, easements and restriction of record. Of said 27.688 acres, all are within P.N. 05-00008.000 and 0.394 acre is within the right-of-way of National Road  $\sim$  U.S. Rte. 40.

## DESCRIPTION OF A 1.957 ACRE TRACT AT 3980 NATIONAL ROAD ~ U.S. RTE. 40, DEER CREEK TOWNSHIP, MADISON CO., OHIO

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Deer Creek Township, in Virginia Military Survey Nos. 6644, 8524 & 12092 and being a 1.957 acre portion of a 29.97 acre tract of land (29.625 acres by recent survey) conveyed to Certified Real Estate, Inc., by deed of record in Official Record 217, Page 267, all records referenced to the Recorder's Office, Madison County, Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set in the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 (variable width), as shown upon Sheet 5 of 13 of the Ohio Department of Transportation Location Plan, Madison County, S.H. 1. SEC.-D-2(pt.) C,B & WEST JEFFERSON(pt.), at the southwest corner of said 29.625 acre tract and at a southeast corner of a 541.791 acre tract of land conveyed, as Parcel Two, to Linda R. Schaefer, Successor Trustee, by deed of record in Official Record 319, Page 1987, said spike being S 86° 23' 22" W a distance of 238.72 feet from a railroad spike set at the intersection of the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 with the centerline of Glade Run Road (50 feet in width);

thence N  $00^{\circ}$  50' 48" E along a portion of the west line of said 29.625 acre tract and along a portion of an east line of said 541.791 acre tract a distance of 200.61 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set (passing a wooded fence post found in the north right-of-way line of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40);

thence N 86° 23' 22" E crossing a portion of said 29.625 acre tract and parallel with and 200 feet northerly from the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road  $\sim$  U.S. Rte. 40 and from the south line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 426.29 feet to a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set;

thence S 00° 50' 48" W crossing a portion of said 29.625 acre tract and parallel with and 425 feet easterly from the west line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 200.61 feet to a Mag nail set in the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road  $\sim$  U.S. Rte. 40 and in the south line of said 29.625 acre tract (passing a 3/4" I.D. iron pipe set in the north right-of-way line of the west bound lane of National Road  $\sim$  U.S. Rte. 40 at 40.12 feet);

thence S  $86^{\circ}$  23' 22" W along the centerline of the west bound lane of National Road ~ U.S. Rte. 40 and along a portion of the south line of said 29.625 acre tract a distance of 426.29 feet to the place of beginning;
