

Situate in the State of Ohio, Madison County, City of London and being a part of VMS 9471 and a part of Lot 7 of the J. Swetland Addition recorded in Plat Book 1 Pg.149 and being all of a 0.152 acre tract (Tract 1) as described in the deed to Christie Allen recorded in Inst. # 201900004604 (O.R. Vol. 357 Pg. 599) (Auditors parcel # 31-02539.000) and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at a 1" O.D. pipe found at the southeastern corner of said Lot 7 and in the west right-of-way of Swetland Ave. & in the north right-of-way of East High St. and at the southeasterly corner of a 0.507 acre tract as described in the deed to USA Investment Group Management recorded in Inst.# 201900002730 (O.R. Vol. 353 Pg. 946);

thence, along the north line of East High St. South 67°49'55"West, 119.06 feet to a cotton spindle spike found at a southwest corner of said 0.507 acre tract and being the true point of beginning;

thence, continuing with the north line of East High St. South 67°49'55"West, 50.00 feet to a 1/2" rebar found in the east line of a 16.5' alley;

thence, along the east line of said alley, North 20°40′16″West, 132.94 feet to a cotton spindle spike found at the southwest corner of a 0.023 acre tract (Tract 2) as described in the deed to Christie Allen recorded in Inst. # 201900004604 (O.R. Vol. 357 Pg. 599);

thence, along the south line of said 0.023 acre tract, North 68°28'42" East, 50.00 feet to a point in a 24" maple tree in the west line of said 0.507 acre tract;

thence, along the west line of said 0.507 acre tract, South 20°40'16"East, 132.38 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.152 acres more or less.

Beginning for reference at an 1" O.D. pipe found at the southeastern corner of said Lot 7 and in the west right-of-way of Swetland Ave. & in the north right-of-way of East High St. and at the southeasterly corner of a 0.507 acre tract as described in the deed to USA Investment Group Management recorded in Inst.# 201900002730 (O.R. Vol. 353 Pg. 946);

thence, along the north line of East High St. South 67°49'55"West, 119.06 feet to a cotton spindle spike found at a southwest corner of said 0.507 acre tract;

thence, continuing with the north line of East High St. South 67°49'55"West, 50.00 feet to a 1/2" rebar found in the east line of a 16.5' alley and the southwest corner of a 0.152 acre tract (Tract 1) as described in the deed to Christie Allen recorded in Inst. # 201900004604 (O.R. Vol. 357 Pg. 599);

thence, along the east line of said alley, North 20°40'16"West, 132.94 feet to a cotton spindle spike found at the northwest corner of said 0.152 acre tract and being the true point of beginning

thence, continuing along the east line of said alley, North 20°40'16"West, 20.00 feet to a 5/8" rebar found at a southwest corner of said 0.507 acre tract;

thence, along a southerly line of said 0.507 acre tract, North $68^{\circ}28'42"$ East, 50.00 feet to a 5/8" rebar found;

thence, along the west line of said 0.507 acre tract, South $20^{\circ}40'16"$ East, 20.00 feet to a point in a 24" maple tree;

thence, along the north line of said 0.152 acre tract, South 68°28'42"West, 50.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.023 acres more or less.
