1.6344 Acre Tract Surveyed for Richard Wilson

The following described 1.6344 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Pleasant Township, VMS 8131, and being part of a 55.475 acre tract (parcel #17-00104.000, Scioto Farm Unit 18) conveyed to William Douglas Copas by official record 244 page 1068, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a centerline monument box found at the intersection of the centerline of State Route 323 (60 feet right-of-way) with the centerline of Hicks Road (Township Road 67)(40 feet right-of-way);

Thence, with the centerline of said Hicks Road, South 21° 08′ 43″ East a distance of 2249.72 feet to a railroad spike found in said centerline at the northeast corner of said 55.475 acre tract and the southeast corner of a 48.796 acre tract (Scioto Farm Unit 17) conveyed to Carol Lynn Wilson by Official Record 197 page 301, also being The True Point of Beginning;

Thence, continuing with said centerline, South 20° 49' 16" East a distance of 287.96 feet to a railroad spike found at the northeast corner of a 0.537 acre tract conveyed to Kimberly Lee Hampton by Official Record 275 page 1665;

Thence, with the north line of said 0.537 acre tract, South 68° 54′ 58" West, passing a1/2 inch diameter iron pipe found at 19.90 feet, a total distance of **195.10 feet** to a 3/4 inch diameter iron pipe found at the northwest corner of said tract;

Thence, with a new line across said 55.475 acre tract, North 26° 07'50"West a distance of **390.11 feet** to an iron pin and cap set in the south line of said 48.796 acre tract;

Thence, with the south line of said 48.796 acre tract, **South 87° 31' 08" East,** passing an iron pin and cap set at 230.73 feet, a total distance of 251.73 feet returning to The True Point of Beginning containing 1.6344 Acres more or less.

Bearings are based on a GPS observation on April 27, 2018, WGS 1984 Geodetic North.

This deed is subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8-inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "Cottrill 6858."
