3.0000 Acre TractSurveyed for Eichorn

The following described 3.0000 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Monroe Township, VMS 2883, being part of a 170.2663 acre tract (Parcel 11-00386.011) conveyed to Enoch and Leanna C Eichorn, Joint Lives by Official Record 377 page 2653, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a mag nail found at the centerline intersection of Woods & West Avenue (County Road 125, 50 feet right-of-way) and Lafayette-Plain City Road (County Road 5, 50 feet right-of-way);

Thence, with the centerline of Woods & West Avenue with the following two courses:

- 1) North 34° 54′ 11″ West a distance of 1038.77 feet to a 1/2 inch diameter pipe found in the line between VMS 2883 and 2882;
- 2) North 23° 51′ 23″ West a distance of 400.09 feet to an iron pin found at the West corner of a 5.000 acre tract conveyed to Jason Everett and Erica Elaine Warren, Joint Lives by Official Record 218 page 1869 and a corner to said 170.2663 acre tract and being the **True Point of Beginning**;

Thence, with the centerline of Woods & West Avenue, **North 23° 37' 41" West** a distance of **460.00 feet** to a mag nail set;

Thence, across said 170.2663 acre tract with the following two new courses:

- 1) North 60° 06′ 01″ East, passing an iron pin and cap set at 25.15 feet, a total distance of 285.80 feet to an iron pin and cap set;
- 2) **South 23° 37′ 41″ East** a distance of **460.00 feet** to an iron pin and cap set in the Northwest line of said Warren's 5 acre tract;

Thence, with the Northwest line of said 5 acre tract, **South 60° 06′ 01″ West**, passing an iron pin and cap previously set at 260.98 feet, a total distance of **285.80 feet** returning to the **True Point of Beginning**, containing **3.0000 Acres** more or less.

Bearings are based on a GPS observation on June 4, 2012, WGS 1984 Geodetic North.

This deed is subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8-inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "Cottrill Surveying"
