

Legal Description Village of West Jefferson, Madison County, Ohio Virginia Military Survey 2836 0.155 Acres

Situated in the Village of West Jefferson, County of Madison, State of Ohio, and in Virginia Military Survey 2836, being all of Lot 46 (Auditor's Parcel Number 10-00391.00) and the south 1/2 of Lot 47 (Auditor's Parcel Number 10-00392.00) in the Jefferson Railroad Addition (Plat Book 1, Page 14), and all of the applicable portion(s) of an alley vacated in Ordinance 15-073 (Official Record Volume 315, Page 1343) as described in Official Record Volume 347, Page 514, conveyed to Asia A. Dodaro and Kaitlin R. Davis, in the Madison County Recorder's Office, being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a 1/2 inch Iron Pipe Found at the north west corner of Lot 41 in said Jefferson Railroad Addition, and in the east line of Washington Street (50 feet Wide);

Thence with the east line of Washington Street, N35°16'01"W 172.00 feet to an Iron Pin Set at the south west corner of Lot 46, said Iron Pin Set being the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence continuing with the east line of Washington Street, **N35°16'01"W 64.50 feet** to an Iron Pin Set at the north west corner of the south half of Lot 47;

Thence leaving Washington Street, partly with a line through Lot 47, being the north line of the south half thereof, and partly with a line through a 10 foot wide alley vacated in the above mentioned Ordinance 15-073, **N54°43′59″E 105.00 feet** to an Iron Pin Set;

Thence with the center of said vacated alley, S35°16'01"E 64.50 feet to an Iron Pin Set;

Thence leaving the center of said vacated alley with a new line through, and partly with the north line of Lot 45, **S54°43'59"W 105.00 feet** to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Containing **0.155 Acres** more or less.

Subject to all existing rights-of-way and easements of record.

The bearings described herein are based on the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD83 (2011) Epoch 2010. The portion of the east line of Washington Street, having a bearing of N35°16'01"W is designated the "basis of bearing" for this survey.

Iron Pins Set are 5/8" diameter x 30" long rebar with red plastic cap stamped "H&S 8915".
