

## Legal Description Pike Township, Madison County, Ohio Virginia Military Surveys 2884 & 5298 4.408 Acres

Situated in the Township of Pike, County of Madison, State of Ohio, and in Virginia Military Surveys 2884 & 5298, being all of the 1.23 Acre Parcel (Auditor's Parcel Number 1500075.000) described in Official Record Volume 408, Page 1825, conveyed to Croplands LLC, and part of the 174.626 Acre Parcel (Auditor's Parcel Number 1500076.004) described in Official Record Volume 423, Page 1842, conveyed to Croplands LLC, being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a 3/4 inch diameter Iron Pin Found in a Monument Box at the centerline intersection of State Route 38 (60' Right-of-Way; MAD-38-15.5-30.02) and Finley-Guy Road C.R. 123 (50' Right-of-Way), being the south west corner of said 174.626 acre tract;

thence with the centerline of Finley Guy Road, S82°32'50"E 2247.76 feet to a Mag Spike Previously Set, and being the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence leaving said Finley Guy Road and with the east line of a 2.000 acre parcel described in Official Record Volume 423, page 1832, passing an Iron Pin Previously Set at 200.00 feet, N10°34'24"E 358.25 feet to an Iron Pin Previously Set in the south line of said 174.626 acre tract;

Thence with a new line through said 174.626 acre parcel, **S75°59'15"E 72.02 feet** to an Iron Pin Previously Set in the original north west corner of said 1.23 acre parcel;

Thence with the original north line of said 1.23 acre parcel, **\$55°42'06"E 191.26 feet** to a Point in the Little Darby Creek;

Thence with a new line through said 174.626 acre parcel, **S64°43'59"E 138.71 feet** to the center of the Little Darby Creek;

Thence with the center of Little Darby Creek and the meanderings thereof, the following nine (9) courses:

\$75°22'11"E 78.34 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

S63°27'14"E 67.18 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

S62°44'32"E 55.42 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

Thence with the centerline of Finley Guy Road, passing a Mag Nail Found at 438.33 feet, and passing a Mag Spike Previously Set at 613.93 feet, **N82°32'50"W 685.93 feet** to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Containing **4.408 Acres** more or less (0.584 acres and 2.590 acres in two pieces for a total of 3.174 acres from said 174.626 acre parcel, and 1.234 acres by survey from said 1.23 acre parcel), of which 0.606 acres Present Right-of-Way Occupied.

Subject to all existing rights-of-way and easements of record.

Situated in the Township of Pike, County of Madison, State of Ohio, and in Virginia Military Surveys 2884, 3153, 4940, 5298, being part of the 174.626 Acre Parcel (Auditor's Parcel Number 1500076.004) described in Official Record Volume 423, Page 1842, conveyed to Croplands LLC, being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a 3/4 inch diameter Iron Pin Found in a Monument Box at the centerline intersection of State Route 38 (60' Right-of-Way; MAD-38-15.5-30.02) and Finley-Guy Road C.R. 123 (50' Right-of-Way), being the south west corner of the tract of which this is a part, said Iron Pin Found being the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence with the centerline of State Route 38, **N05°40'40"E 1126.08 feet** to a Mag Spike Previously Set;

Thence continuing with the centerline of State Route 38, **N05°45'22"E 1603.36 feet** to a Mag Spike Previously Set in a south line of the 246.685 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 410, Page 1632, conveyed to Fair Acres Farms on the Darby LLC;

Thence leaving said State Route 38 and with a south line of said 246.685 acre tract, passing Iron Pins Previously Set at 35.00 feet and 2010.45 feet, **S89°09'31"E 2045.45 feet** to a Mag Spike Previously Set in the centerline of Voglesburgh Road C.R. 124 (40' Right-of-Way);

Thence with the centerline of Vogelsburgh Road the following four (4) courses:

Passing a 1/2 inch diameter Iron Pin Found (2 inches deep) at 647.21 feet, **\$00°48'20"E 989.85 feet** to 3/4 inch diameter Iron Pipe Found;

Passing a Mag Nail Found at 457.38 feet, **S18°54'03"E 623.80 feet** to a PK Nail Found (1 inch deep);

\$18°38'40"E 249.99 feet to a 1/2 inch diameter Iron Pin Found (1 inch deep); and

**\$32°06'49"E 258.59 feet** to a PK Nail Found (1 inch deep) at the southern corner of the 5.061 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 347, Page 1770, conveyed to Angela J. Critchfield and Richard D. Critchfield;

Thence leaving Vogelsburgh Road, partly with a south east line of said 5.061 acre tract, and partly with a south east line of the 20.001 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 349, Page 2595, conveyed to John E. Wilson and Christina R. Wilson, passing a 1/2 inch diameter Iron Pipe Found (Leaning) at 455.34 feet, **N54°59'46"E 622.10 feet** to an Iron Pin Previously Set at the north west corner of the 10-1/4 acre Tract 2 described in Official Record Volume 313, Page 2595, conveyed to Resaca Land Holdings, LLC;

Thence with the south west line of said 10-1/4 acre Tract 2, **S33°33'43"E 1021.46 feet** to a 5/8 inch diameter Rebar Found (MCCARTY ASSOC) in a north west line of the 40 acre Tract 3 also described in Official Record Volume 313, Page 2595, and conveyed to Resaca Land Holdings, LLC;

Thence partly with a north west line of said 40 acre Tract 3 and partly with a north west line of the original 4.866 acre tract described in Official Record Volume 318, Page 57, conveyed to John E. Wilson and Christina R. Wilson, passing 5/8 inch diameter Rebars Found at 302.48 feet and 627.88 feet, passing a Mag Nail Found at 647.97 feet, and passing a 5/8 inch diameter Rebar Found (MCCARTY ASSOC) at 667.80 feet, **S55°37'51"W 813.33 feet** to a Point in the center of Little Darby Creek;

Thence with the center of Little Darby Creek and the meanderings thereof, the following eight (8) courses:

N69°24'35"W 71.18 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N85°03'24"W 94.34 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N68°30'00"W 38.17 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N65°14'35"W 68.43 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N65°21'44"W 68.75 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N62°44'32"W 55.42 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N63°27'14"W 67.18 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

N75°22'11"W 78.34 feet to a Point at the center of Little Darby Creek;

Thence departing from the centerline of the Little Darby Creek, on a new line through said 174.626 acre parcel, **N64°43'59"W 138.71 feet** to a point within the banks of the Little Darby Creek from which an iron pin Previously Set bears S10°31'10"W 98.50 feet, said point also being the northeast corner of the 1.23 acre parcel described in Official Record Volume 408, Page 1825, conveyed to Croplands LLC;

Thence with a north line of said 1.23 acre Parcel **N55°42'06"W 191.26 feet** to an Iron Pin Previously Set;

Thence with a new line through said 174.626 acre tract, **N75°59'15"W 72.02 feet** to an Iron Pin Previously Set;

Thence with the north line of the original 2.000 acre parcel described in Official Record Volume 423, Page 1832, conveyed to Croplands LLC, **N46°14'23"W 208.40 feet** to an Iron Pin Previously Set;

Thence with the north lines of the original 2.068 acre parcel described in Official Record Volume 423, Page 1832, conveyed to Croplands LLC, the following two (2) courses crossing the Little Darby Creek;

N64°53'09"W 28.38 feet to a Point;

\$78°15'00"W 158.29 feet to an Iron Pin Previously Set;

Thence passing an Iron Pin Previously Set at 255.76 feet, **\$23°39'15"W 455.76 feet** to a Mag Spike Previously Set in the centerline of Finley-Guy Road;

Thence with the centerline of Finley-Guy Road, N82°32'50"W 1795.63 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

Containing **171.452 Acres** more or less, of which 4.808 acres Present Right-of-Way Occupied. Subject to all existing rights-of-way and easements of record.
