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1.3121 Acre Tract

The following described 1.3121 acre tract is situated in the State of Ohio, Madison County, Oak Run Township, VMS 1020 and VMS 4124, being all of a 0.25 acre tract (First Tract: Parcel 13-00117.000) and all of a 1 acre tract (Second Tract: Parcel 13-00117.00) both conveyed to Ronald T McGough and Cindy A Ponyah, Joint Lives by Official Record 365 page 2579, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found at the centerline intersection of Big Plain-Circleville Road (County Road for, 50 feet right-of-way) and Gregg Mill Road (Township Road 100, 50 feet right-of-way) and being the Northeast corner of said 1 acre tract;

Thence, with the centerline of Gregg Mill Road, **South 05° 59' 57" East** a distance of **157.03 feet** to a 3/4 inch diameter iron pin found at the Northeast corner of a 6.157 acre tract conveyed to Jesse E and Trudy S Bobo, Joint Lives by Official Record 296 page 217;

Thence, with said 6.157 acre tract with the following two courses:

- 1) North 85° 36′ 44″ West, passing an iron pin and cap set at 35.00 feet, passing the Southeast corner of said 0.25 acre tract at 311.91 feet, a total distance of 381.59 feet to a double angle iron fence post found;
- 2) North 05° 05′ 46″ East, passing a double angle iron fence post found 0.21 feet left of line at 127.63 feet, a total distance of 157.59 feet to a railroad spike found in the centerline of Big Plain-Circleville Road;

Thence, with the centerline of Big Plain-Circleville Road, **South 85° 06′ 10″ East**, passing an iron pin found at the Northwest corner of said 1 acre tract at 69.67 feet, a total distance of **351.34 feet** returning to the **Point of Beginning**, containing **1.3121 Acres** more or less, of which 0.2516 acres more or less is all of said 0.25 acre tract and 1.0605 acres more or less is all of said 1 acre tract.

Bearings are based on the centerline of Glade Run Road (South 22° 41′ 30″ West) as described in Official Record 161 page 14.

Subject to and with the benefit of all legal highways, restrictions, easements, limitations, and reservations, of record, if any and to zoning restrictions which have been imposed thereon, if any.

All iron pins set are 5/8-inch diameter rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "Cottrill Surveying"
