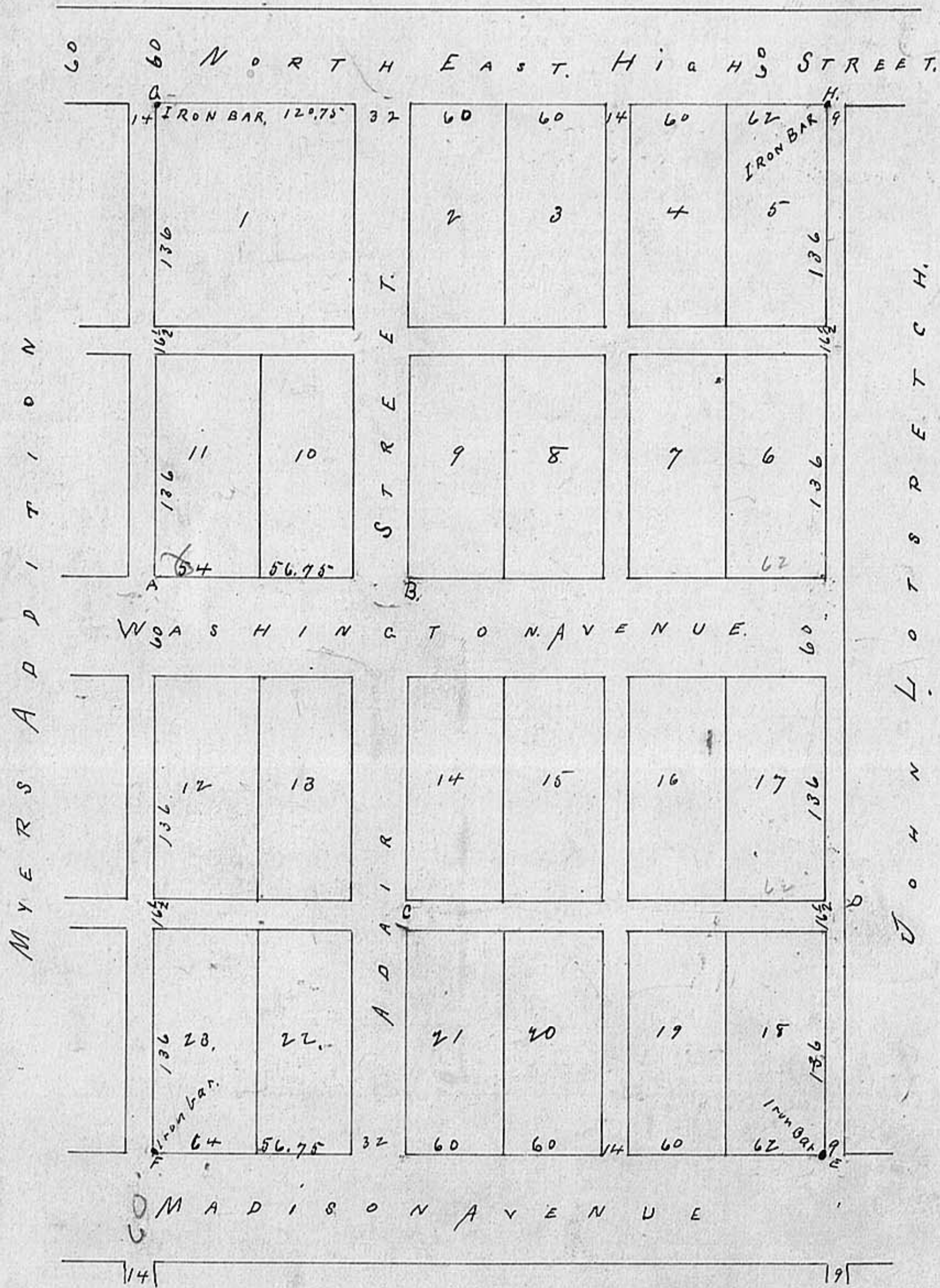
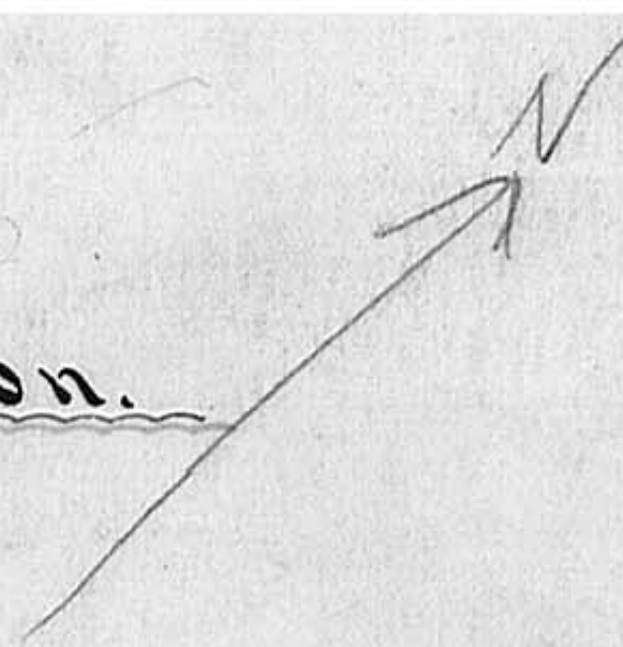

P. Adairs. Addition

The within addition is predicated upon four iron Bars driven one each at A. B. C. & D. From G. to H. & E to F are each 41 3/4 ft From F to G & E. to H each 63 1/2 feet: First the addition embraces the area A. B. C. D. E. F. Lots Streets & Alleys (see Map. Sketch). The lots included in the addition are Nos 12, 13, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 & 23, all the lots are each 136 ft long. Lots 12 & 23 are each 64 ft wide. Lots Nos 13 & 23 are each 56 3/4 ft wide. Lots Nos 19, 20 & 21 are each 60 ft wide and Lot No 18 is 62 feet wide. Washington & Madison Avenue are, each 60 feet wide and Adair St is 32 ft wide. Alley The alley between Washington and Madison Avenues, is 16 1/2 ft wide. Alley between Lots Nos 19 & 20 is 14 ft wide and the half alley between lot No 18 and J. E. Lots piech is 9 feet wide. when the within addition is made 2.15 acres of land must be dropped and the foregoing lots appraised and put upon the duplicate instead thereof.

Know all men by these presents. That Preston Adair and Hannah Adair, his wife have adopted the above plat and description of Lots, Streets and Alleys caused to be laid off by the said Preston Adair under the name of, Preston Adairs Subdivision of Land and Addition to the Town of London in the County of Madison and State of Ohio and numbered the same for record in the proper office, in dedicating to Public use the Streets and Alleys therein set forth, and acknowledged the same to be their voluntary act and deed for the uses and purposes therein expressed Witness our hands and seals this 27th day of May A.D. 1884.
