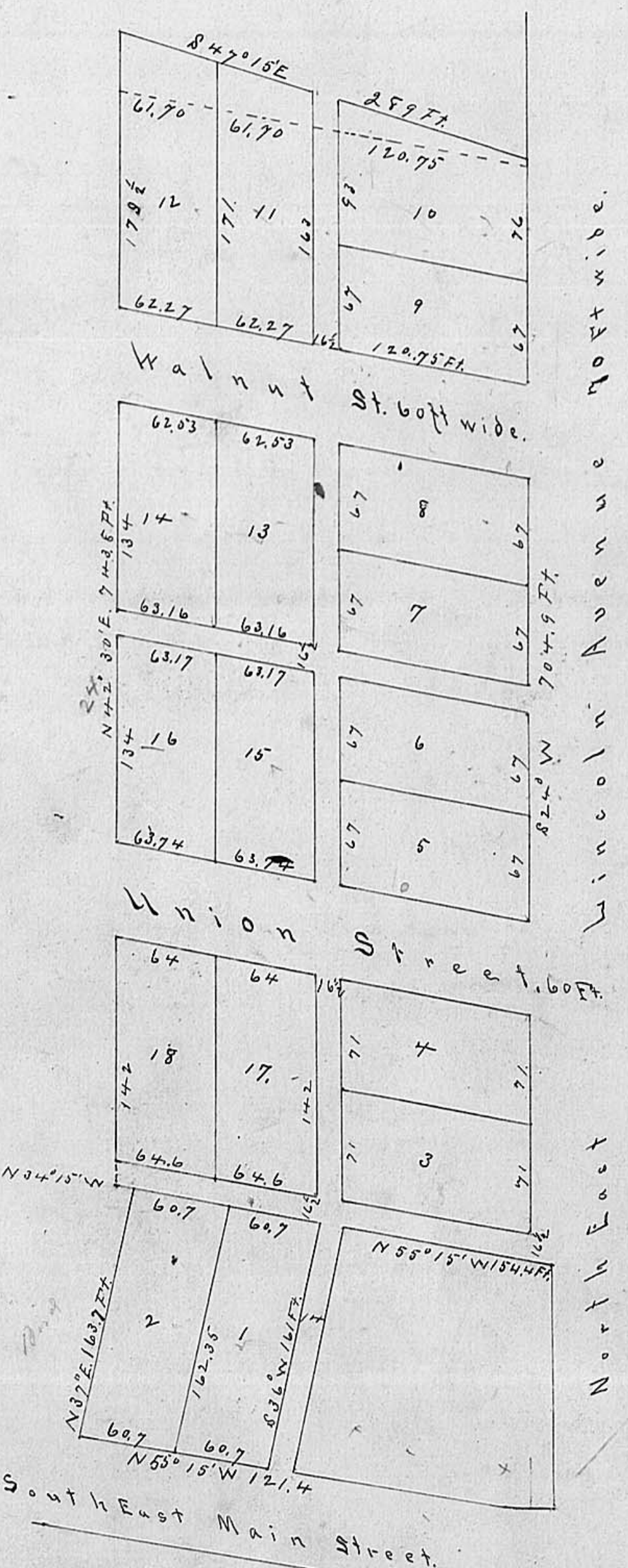

Bank Addition.

Sub-division of the James Collett's Lot. Description of within Addition. Lots, Nos. 1 & 2 are each 60.7 feet on S. E. Main St & on alley measuring from the center of Main St the S. E. line of Lot No 1 is 161 feet N. W. line of Lot No 2 is 163.7 ft & between 1 & 2 is 163.35 ft. Lots 3 & 4, 71 ft front & back & 120.75 ft deep. Lots Nos 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9 are each & back and 120.75 feet deep. Lot No 10 is 76 ft on Lincoln Avenue, 93 ft on alley, 120.75 ft on lot. No 9 & in ft in Jones land. Lot No 11 is 62.27 ft on Walnut St, 16.3 ft on alley, 171 ft on Lot No 12, 7 ft on Jones land, Lot No. is 62.27 ft on Walnut St 171 on Lot No 11, 179.5 on Martin Malay & ft on Jones land Lots Nos 13, 14, 15 & 16 are each 134 ft deep. Lots 13 & 14 are each 62.53 ft on Walnut St & 63.16 feet on alley. Lots Nos 15 & 16 are each 63.74 ft on Union St & 63.17 on alley. Lots Nos 17 & 18 are each 142 ft from Union St to alley 64 ft on Union St and 64.6 on alley. Lincoln Avenue is 70 ft wide. Union and Walnut Sts each 60 ft wide. Alleys. Alley by Lot No 1 is 14 ft wide. all other alleys are 16 1/2 ft wide.
