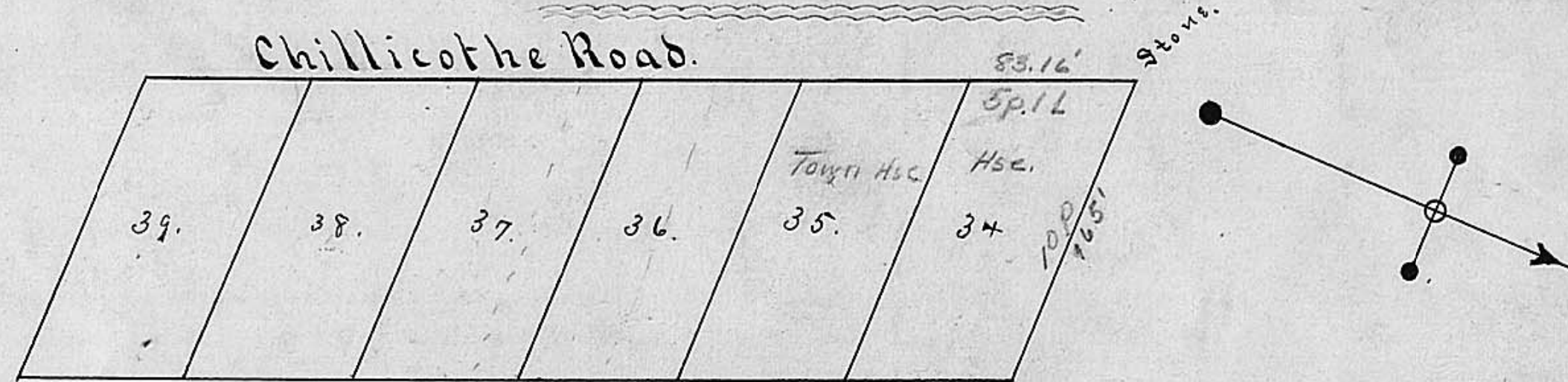

Addition to the town of Pleasant Valley the lots above Represented are situated on the east side and binds on the road leading from Sandusky to Chillicothe lot No 34 is 16 1/2 feet South 24° E from the southeast corner of lot No 12 in said town of Pleasant Valley said lots runs South 24° E 5 poles and one link in front and East 10 poles back all the lots are of the same dimensions and are lines parallel as above represented and are numbered from 34 to 39 inclusive a Stone of about Seventy five pounds weight has been placed at the Northwest corner of Lot No 34 upon which the survey of said lots are predicated
