Isaac Bigelows Second addition

The above Plat is the second addition to the Town of Pleasant Valley Commencing at Lot No 40 after Planting a stone at letter A. The north west corner of said Lot, said Lot being a fractional lot lying on the south side of the street and being three poles and Eleven links in width and running ten poles back, and Lots Nos 41, 42, 43, 44 are four poles and Eleven links in front and running ten poles back; Lot No 45 is seven poles in front and ten poles back and nine poles in width on the back side with the North East Corner cut off by the Chillicothe Road. All the streets and alleys of said addition are 30 links in width Streets and alleys lying at right angles with S 1° 30' W each other, original course of the Post road due east variation one and one half degrees, course of Main Street or Post road now S 88° 30' E. & Lots running S 1° 30' W
