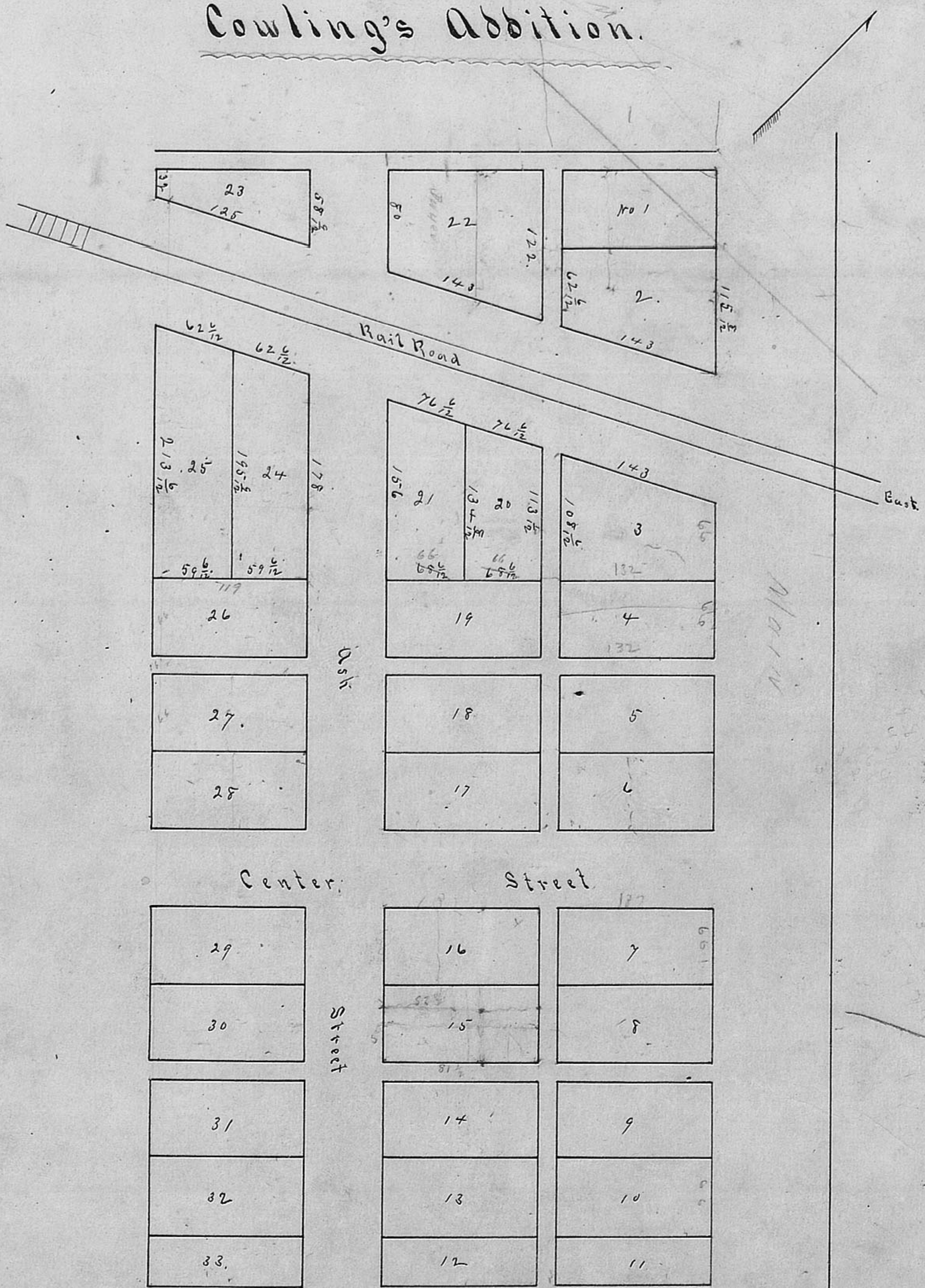

## Cowlings, Addition

Plan of Cowlings addition to the Town of London. Predicated on a stone which has been Planted at the North East corner of Lot No 1 from which the South East corner of out Lot No 3 in the Town of London bears North  $44^{\circ}$  West  $16\frac{1}{2}$  feet. Lot No 2 is  $115\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide on main Street  $62\frac{1}{2}$  on alley and 143 on Rail Road. No 22 is 122 feet wide on alley 143 on R. Road and 80 on oak Street No 23 is  $58\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide on oak Street, 125 on Rail Road and 32 on Phifers line No 3 is 66 feet wide on main Street 143 on Rail Road and  $108\frac{1}{2}$  on alley No 20 is  $113\frac{1}{2}$  on alley  $76\frac{1}{2}$  on Rail Road, 156 on oak Street and  $68\frac{1}{2}$  on No 19. No 24 is 178 wide on Oak Street  $62\frac{1}{2}$  on Rail Road  $195\frac{1}{2}$  on No 25, and  $59\frac{1}{2}$  on No 26. No 25 is  $62\frac{1}{2}$  on Rail Road  $213\frac{1}{2}$  on Phifers line  $59\frac{1}{2}$  on No 26. No 26 is 119 long 66 wide. Nos 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 & 19 are 66 wide and 132 long. Nos 11 and 12 are 42 feet wide 137 long No 33 is 42 feet wide and 132 long. Oak Street bears  $S 44^{\circ}$  East and is 66 feet wide Center Street bears  $S 46^{\circ}$  West and is 66 feet wide. Alleys  $16\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide.
