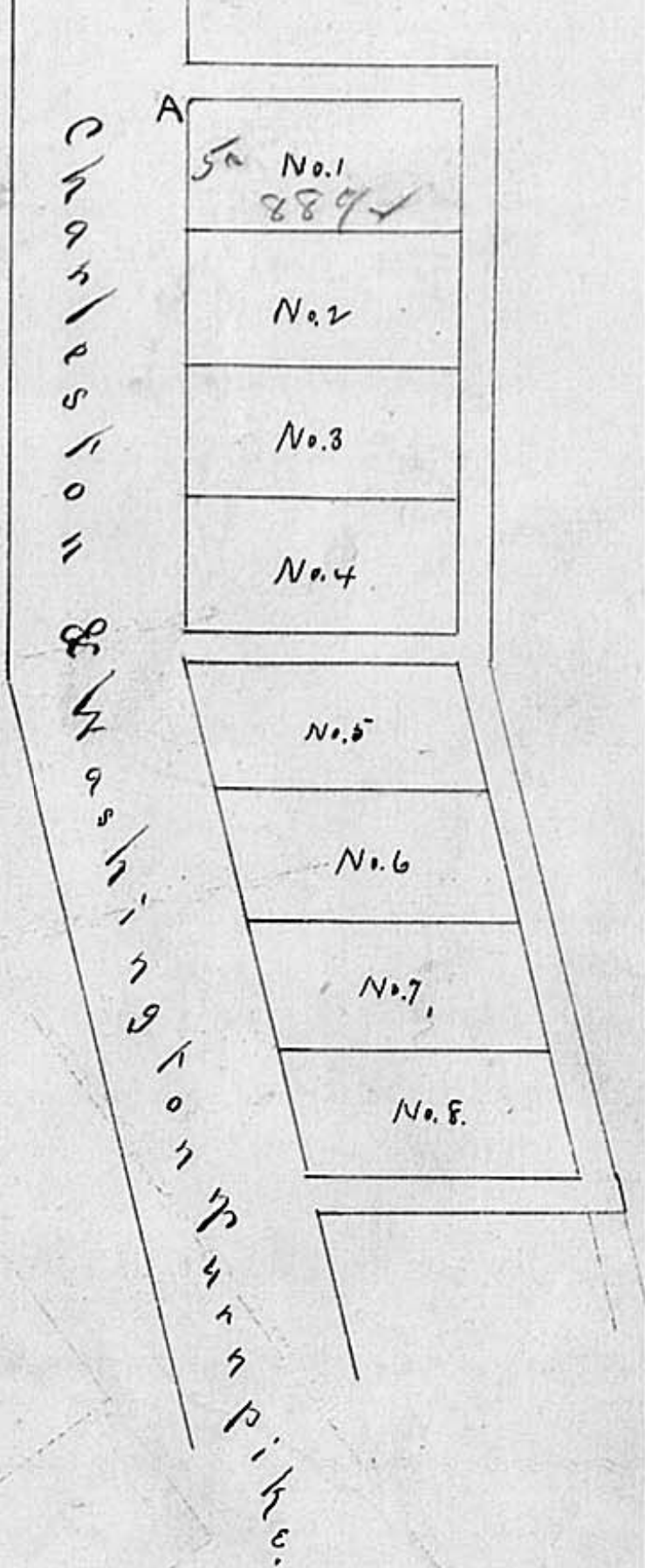

Beginning at a Stone Marked A. on the Plat. and S 2 1/2° E 114 feet from the South west corner of Lot No 24, of the old Town plat and Lots No 1, 2, 3. and 4. fronting on the Charleston and Washington Turnpike S 2 1/2° E 50 feet front and running back N 88 1/2° E 100 feet with an alley betwixt Lots No 4 & 5 of 8 feet. and also Lots No 5, 6, 7, 8. fronting on said Pike lying S 15 1/2° E 50 feet front and running back N 88 1/2° E 100 feet with an alley on the South side of Lot No 8 of eight feet and an alley of 10 feet on the back part of said 8 Lots.
