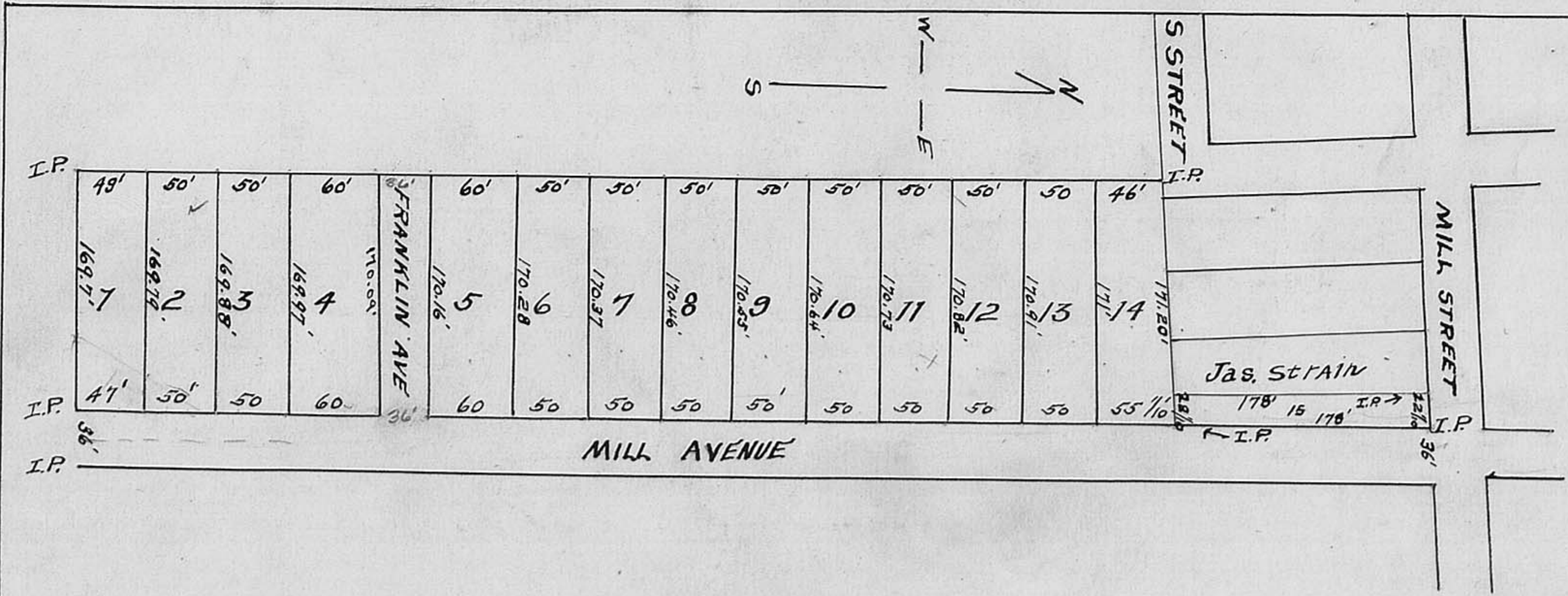

SUBDIVISION OF

Tract No 2 of 2.48 acres and tract no. 4 of 1 acre of land deeded by J. N. Jenkins to Mary L. Dillon and recorded in Volume 92 page 255 of Madison County Deed Records; all lots except no 15 are laid off perpendicular to Mill Avenue, which is 36 feet wide and extends north to Mill Street.

Lot no. 1 is 47 feet in front and 49 feet in rear; Lots Nos. 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 are each 50 feet in front and rear; Lots Nos. 4 and 5 are each 60 feet in front and rear; Lot No. 14 is 55 1/10 feet in front and 46 feet in rear; Lot no. 15 lies parallel to Mill Avenue and fronts on Mill Street; it is 22 1/10 feet in front and rear and extends 178 feet along Mill Avenue. The depth of all lots are as indicated on the plat. Mill Avenue and Franklin Avenue are each 36 feet wide. Mary L. Dillon, the owner, gives 24 4/10 feet of the width of Mill Avenue and all of Franklin Avenue.
