

# Plain City

D. D. Dorniny's Addition

Daniel D. Dorniny's addition to Plain City, said addition is situated on the South Side of the Rail Road and is a continuation of Rail Road Street and lies within the incorporated Village of Plain City. Said Addition is Predicated upon lines platted at A 7 B, N. W. corner of Lot No 14. N. E. corner of Lot 16. Lot No 1 is on the east side of Rail Road Street, fronting said Street by 75 feet, the north line is 157 1/2 feet, the east line 49 1/4 feet and the south line 157 1/2 feet and at right angles with said R. R. Street. Lots No 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 are each 42 feet front running back at right angles and increasing in length from 157 1/2 feet to 160 1/2 feet as is shown by the accompanying Plat. Lots Nos 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, & 15 are each 42 feet front and are on the west side of said Rail Road Street, and progressing in length from 111 1/2 feet the north line of Lot No 9 to 118 feet, North line of Lot No 15. Lot No 16 is 118 feet on the south line, 80 feet front 120 1/2 feet on the north line and 101 feet on the west. There is an alley along the west line of Lots No 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & 16 of 16 feet laid out in this addition and on the East line of Lots No 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8, of 15 feet laid out in Black and Mooreys addition. Rail Road Street is 40 feet in width. There is an alley of 16 feet between Lots 2 & 3, 4 & 5 and on the South side of No 8 & 9, also between Lots No 12 & 13, 14 & 15. There is also an alley of 16 1/4 feet between No 6 & 7, & 10 & 11. Said addition contains three and one fourth acres being a part of Survey No 7064.

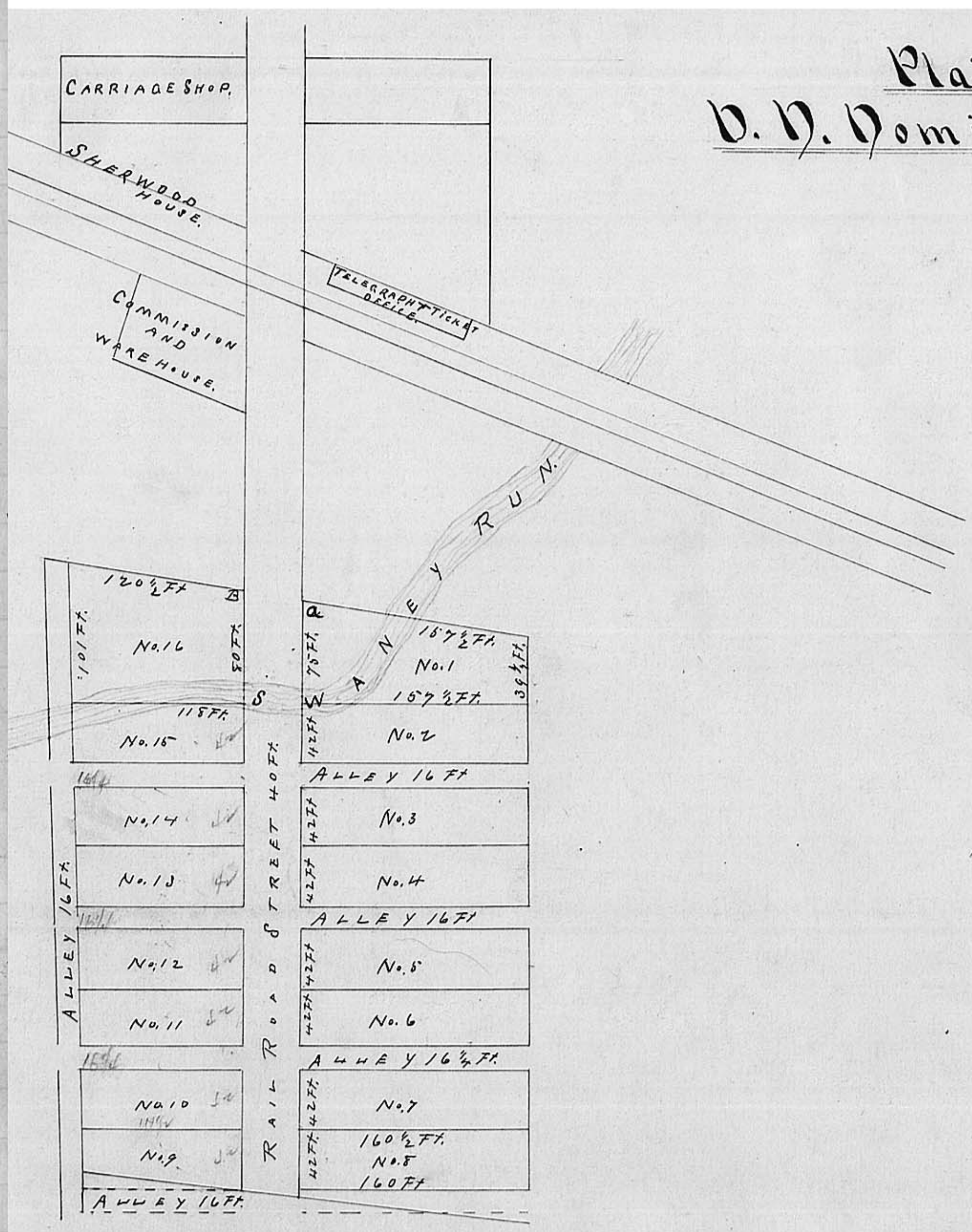
