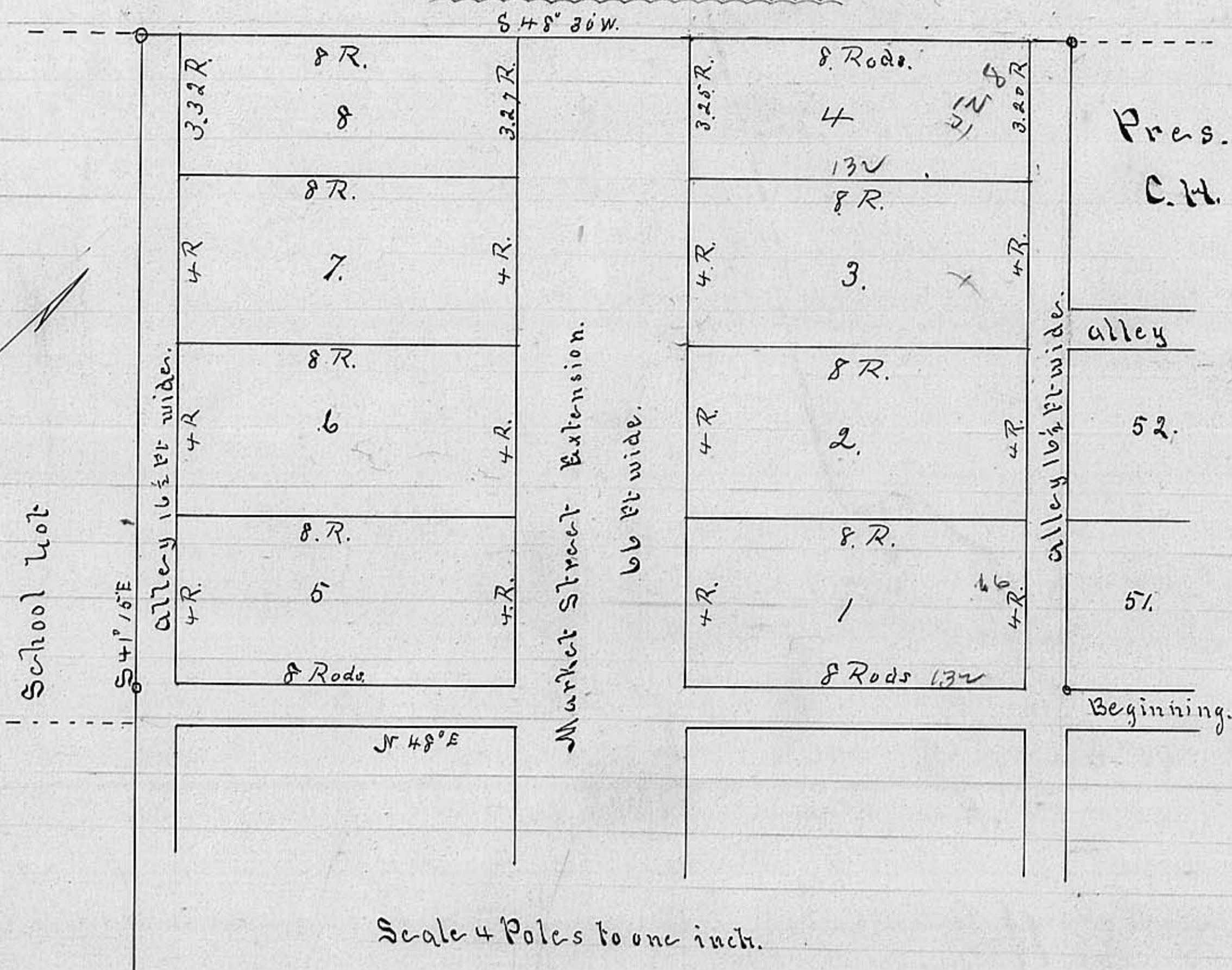

Dougllass & Marcy's Addition

Douglass and Marcy's addition to the village of Mt Sterling Madison County Ohio. Beginning at a stake the Southwesterly corner of Lot No 51 in said Village thence with the Southwesterly lines of Lots Nos 51 & 52 and also with the Southwesterly line of the Presbyterian Church Lot No 41° W 15.20 Poles to a stake in the Southerly line of Lot No one in the sub-division of John O Days land: thence with the southerly lines of Lots Nos 1 & 2, of said O Days Lands S 48.30' W 22 Poles to a stake a corner of the School Lot, thence S. 41° 15' E 15.32 Poles to a stake thence with the Northwesterly line of an alley N 48° 22' Poles to the beginning containing two acres and 15.72 Poles of Land and being a part of Scott's original survey no 6483, 46945 said Addition is laid off into Eight Lots, one Street and two alleys. Lots No 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7 are each four rods front on Market Street as extended and Eight Rods deep. Containing 32 Poles of Land, each. Lot No 4 is 3.25 on Market Street and Eight rods deep tapering in width to 3.20 rods front on northeasterly alley containing 25.80 Poles. Lot No 8 is 3.27 Rods front on Market Street and Eight Rods deep tapering to 3.32 Rods front on the Southwesterly alley. Containing 26.36 Poles of Land. Market Street extension contains 61.04 Poles of land the northeastern alley contains 15.20 Poles of Land and Southwestern alley contains 15.32 Poles of Land all of which Street and Alleys contain 91.56 Poles of Land. Be it Remembered that on the day of April A. D. 1882. before me the undersigned a Justice of the Peace in and for said County, personally came the above named D. H. Douglass and H. D. Marcy the Grantors in the foregoing addition to the Plat of the Village of Mt Sterling in Madison County Ohio, and acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof to be their voluntary act for the uses and purposes therein mentioned, in Testimony whereof, I have hereunto subscribed my name on the day and year last aforesaid.

It is hereby certified that on the 7th day of April A. D. 1882. the within addition to the Plat of the Village of Mt Sterling was duly approved by the Council of said Village as corresponding in all respects to the streets alleys & Lots on the original plat of said Village, witness our hands and seal of the said Village on the day and year above written.
