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W. R. Fickley's addition.

Beginning at a stone and stake marked No 1 and 12 feet from the north west corner of Lot No 5 in Hancock's addition, and being Lot No 1 on the plat and fronting on Walnut Street 42 1/2 feet, 106 feet back, and on the alley 103 feet, and on the Depot Lot 124 feet and lots No 2 + 3 fronting on Center Street 50 feet running back 100 feet, and Lot No 4 fronting on Center Street 67 1/2 feet, 100 feet back, on the alley 9 feet on the Depot lot 117 feet, No 5 + 6 fronting on Center Street 47 feet front running back 100 feet. Lot No 7, 47 feet front 112 feet back on the south line and 92 on the north line Lot No 8 fronting on Center Street 43 1/2 feet, on the south line running back 92 feet and on the north 67. Lot No 9 is a fraction bounded the East by the mill Race and 53 feet on the south with Lot No 11 Hancock's Addition and N 4 1/2 W 118 feet to the south east corner of Lot No 7.
