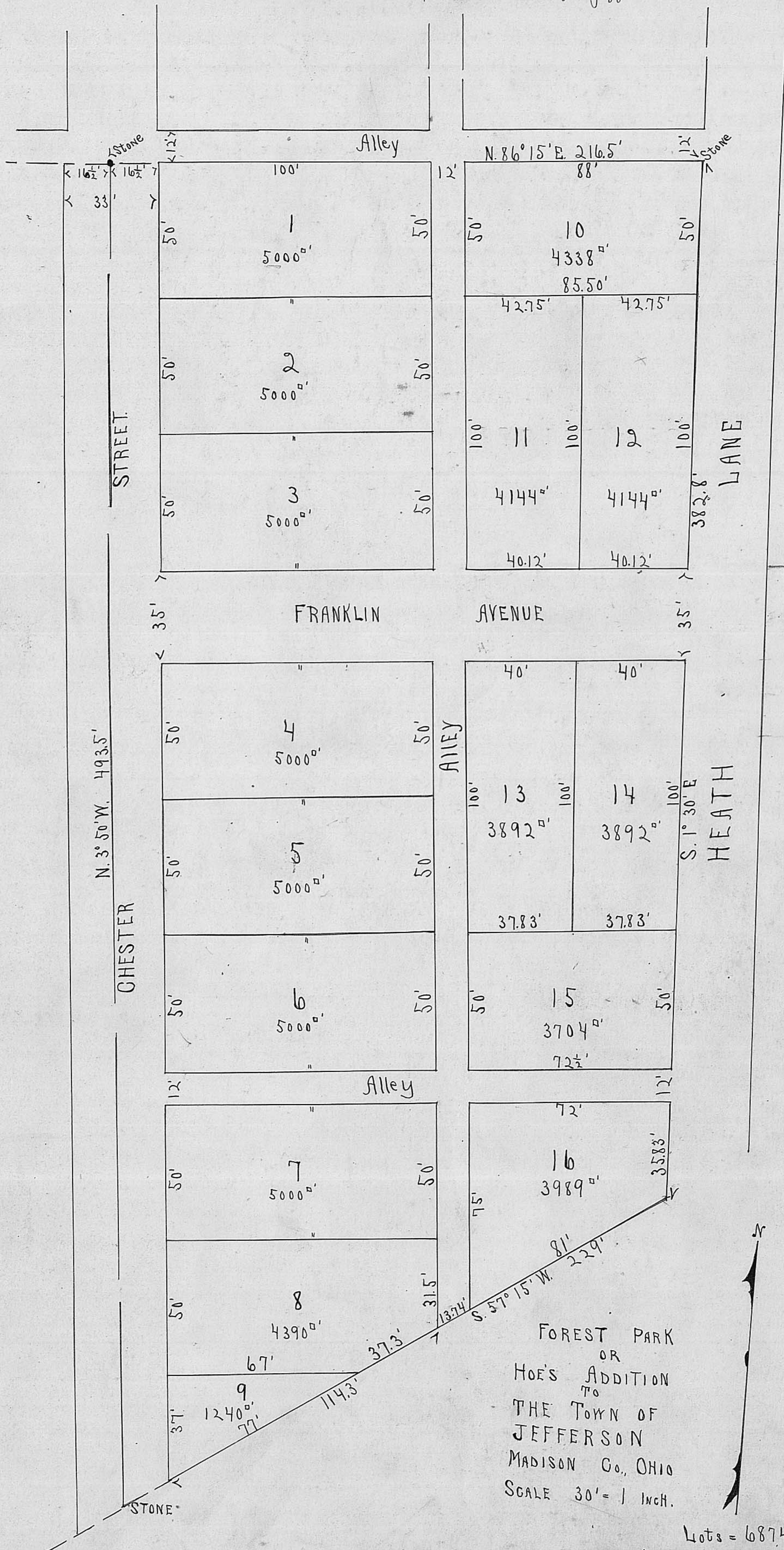


Forest Park or Hoe's addition to the Town of Jefferson.

London, Ohio June 19th 1903.

At the instance of Frank W. Hoe I have surveyed the following described tract of land: Beginning at a stone northeast corner to a tract of land owned by H. A. Gregg and in the south line of a 12 foot alley and being in the center of the south end of Chester Street in the town of Jefferson; thence with said line N 86° 15' E 216.50 feet to a stone in the west line of the Heath lane; thence with said line S 1° 15' E 382.80 feet to a post; thence with a line of Sarah Heath S 57° 15' W 229 feet to a stone corner to said Gregg; thence with the east line of said Gregg S 3° 50' W 493.50 feet to the beginning containing 90776 square feet of land. Survey No 2836.

I have also divided the same into lots, streets and alleys as shown by the accompanying plat. All alleys being 12 feet wide, Franklin Street being 35 feet wide, and the east one-half of Chester Street being 16 1/2 feet wide.

The following table shows the dimensions and areas of the lots the N. E. S. and W. denoting north, east, south and west, respectively;

The total area of the lots laid out is 68743 square feet and of the streets and alleys 22033 square feet making a total of 90776 square feet.

The said lots to be known as Forest Park Addition to the town of Jefferson, Madison County, Ohio.
