## Gould & Gould & Weldon. Subdivision of Out-Lots No. 2 & 3.

Goulds Subdivision to the Town of London being the subdivision No. 3 in said town. Oak Street is  $4\frac{1}{2}$  poles wide one half of said width is taken from said Out Lot No. 3. all of the alleys in said subdivision as laid down in the annexed plat are  $16\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide all the lots of the said division are 132 feet in length from N. E. to S. W. No. 1 is 23 feet on Main Street (a stone at the East corner thereof is planted it being also the beginning corner to Bowlings addition to London) No. 2 extends  $60\frac{1}{4}$  feet on oak Street on the N. E. side thereof No. 3 on the N. E. side of oak Street fronts 62 feet and 8 inches on the same. No. 4 also on the N. E. side of Oak Street extends five poles and 9 links on the same to a point on the line of Columbus and Springfield Rail Road said subdivision is situated wholly on the N. E. side of Oak Street and S. W. of Main Street.

Gould and Weldons Subdivision of Out Lot No. 2 in the Town of London. Oak Street as laid in the annexed Plat is  $4\frac{1}{2}$  poles wide half of which width is taken from the N. E. side of said out lot all the alleys in said subdivision are  $16\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide. The lots in said subdivision are each 132 feet in length from N. E. to S. W. and of the following widths respectively on the streets which they front viz. Subdivision No. 1 fronts  $57\frac{1}{2}$  feet on oak Street and is 95 feet and 8 inches in width on the alley No. 2 fronts 62 feet and 8 inches on oak Street. No. 3 fronts 62 feet and 8 inches on oak Street and No. 4 fronts 60 feet and 9 inches on oak Street said lots are on the S. W. side of oak Street. No. 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 are all situated on the N. E. side of Water Street, and of the following dimensions No. 5 and 6 are each 47 and 10 inches in width fronting said Water Street. No. 7 and 8 are each 62 feet and 8 inches in width fronting on said Water Street and No. 9 is sixty feet and 9 inches in width and fronting on said Water Street. Thereby Certify that the subdivision of out Lots No. 2 and 3 as above described and as represented by the annexed are correct and true.

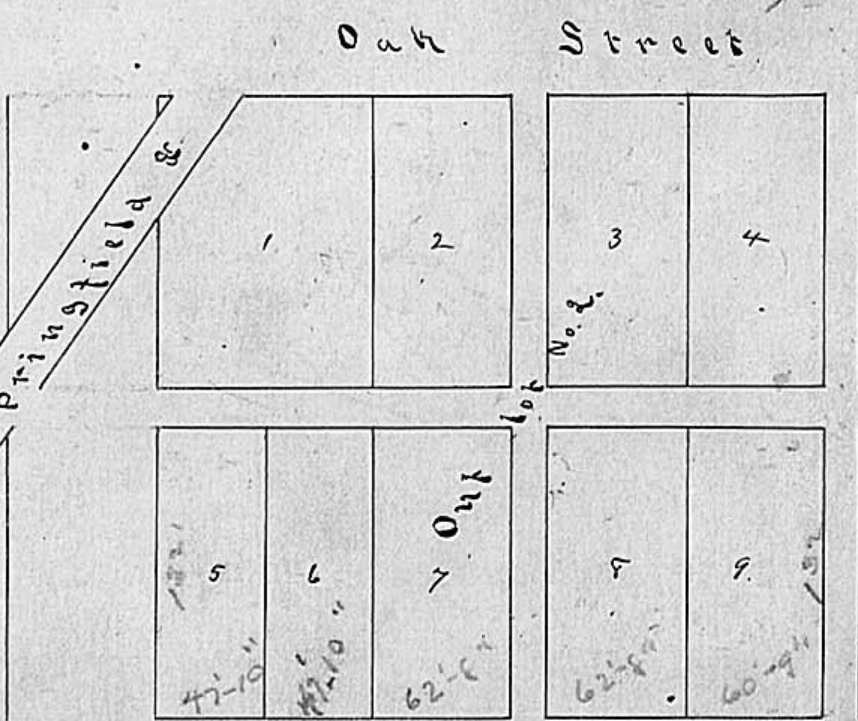
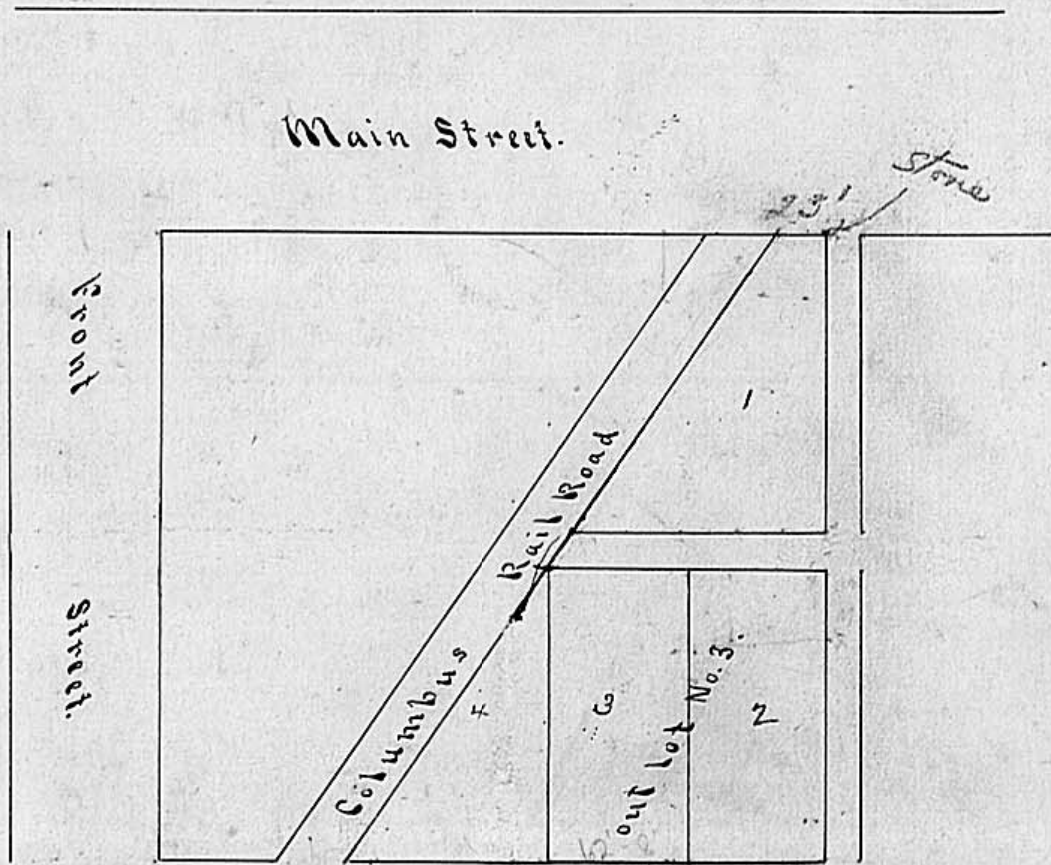
