

Aurelius Hager et al. Addition

Aurelius Hager's Addition to Plain City. Said addition is predicated upon a stone S. W corner to Lot No 1 the south line of said lot is 80 feet the east line is 227 feet, the north line is 80 feet & the west line is 227 feet, there are two streets one running North & S & one E & W each 40 feet wide, and all the alleys are each 18 feet long. Lots No 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 are each $64\frac{1}{3}$ feet wide and $113\frac{1}{3}$ feet long on the west of Lot No 7 there is a fraction same length as of the N line is 41 feet & the S. line $6\frac{1}{3}$ feet. Lot No 8 is same length the north line of said lot is $70\frac{2}{3}$ feet and the south line is $35\frac{1}{3}$ feet there is a stone planted at the S. E. corner of lot No 13 the amount of land is.

D.S. Lombard's addition to Plain City is predicated upon stone planted at C + D. Lots No 17, 18 are each 54 feet & 10 inches wide & $128\frac{1}{3}$ feet long. Lot No 19, the east line is 54 feet & 10 inches west line is 49 feet & bounded in the R.R. No 16 is $64\frac{1}{3}$ feet wide & the E line $158\frac{1}{3}$ feet, the west line is 155 feet & bounded on the R.R. No 15 is $64\frac{1}{3}$ ft wide & the E line 155 feet the west line $151\frac{1}{2}$ feet. No 14 is on the E side $151\frac{1}{4}$ feet on the south 43 feet & on the N $87\frac{1}{3}$ feet. Bounded on the R.R. & on the west by a street of 30 feet. No 22 the N and south lines are each 128 feet the west line is 54 feet & 10 inches & the E line $63\frac{1}{2}$ feet. No 21 is 54 & 10 inches wide & 128 feet long. No 20 is 128 feet long the west line is 57 feet & the East line is 64 feet and bounded on the R.R. No 23 is 64 feet wide & the west line is $182\frac{1}{3}$ feet & the East line is $185\frac{1}{3}$ feet & bounded on the R.R. the alley E of said lot is 10ft. Lots No 24 & 25 are bounded on main street and are each 54 feet wide and the west line of No 24, is 227 feet & the East line 224 feet the last line represents the west line of Lot No 25 & the East line is 82 feet there is 4 feet East of No 25 dedicated for the purpose of an alley there is 6 feet claimed as never having been deeded.

Ambrose Beach's addition is Lot No 26 fronting main street it is 5 poles and 12 links wide and 18 poles & 10 feet long.

Woodruff's Addition is Lot No 27 with 4 poles and 6 links on main street 13 poles & 9 links on west line 8 poles on south line and 13 poles & 18 links on mechanics street.

Mooney's addition is Lot No 28 the N line is 8 poles the west line $86\frac{2}{3}$ ft the S. line 138 ft and the East line along mechanics street 88 feet.

Lathams addition is Lot No 29 with 4 P + 14 links on mechanics street the north line 14 P & 9 links, the west line 4 P + 8 links and the south line 16 P + 14 links.

Hodskins addition is lot No 30 the north line is 16 P + 14 links thence back to the R.R., thence with the R.R. to mechanics street thence to the beginning.

Correction

This Plat is incorrect in the following lots, to wit,

The Aurelius Hager's Addition Lots No 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 are each $63\frac{1}{3}$ feet front instead of $64\frac{1}{3}$ feet,

Lot No 8 the north line is $68\frac{2}{3}$ feet and the south line is $33\frac{1}{3}$ feet.

The error in Lombard's addition is as follows. Lots 17 & 18 are $124\frac{2}{3}$ feet instead of $128\frac{1}{3}$ feet. Lot No 19 is $126\frac{2}{3}$ feet. Lot No 16 is $62\frac{1}{3}$ feet wide. Lot No 15 is $62\frac{1}{3}$ feet wide. Lot No 14 is 111 feet on the south and on the N $85\frac{1}{3}$ feet.
