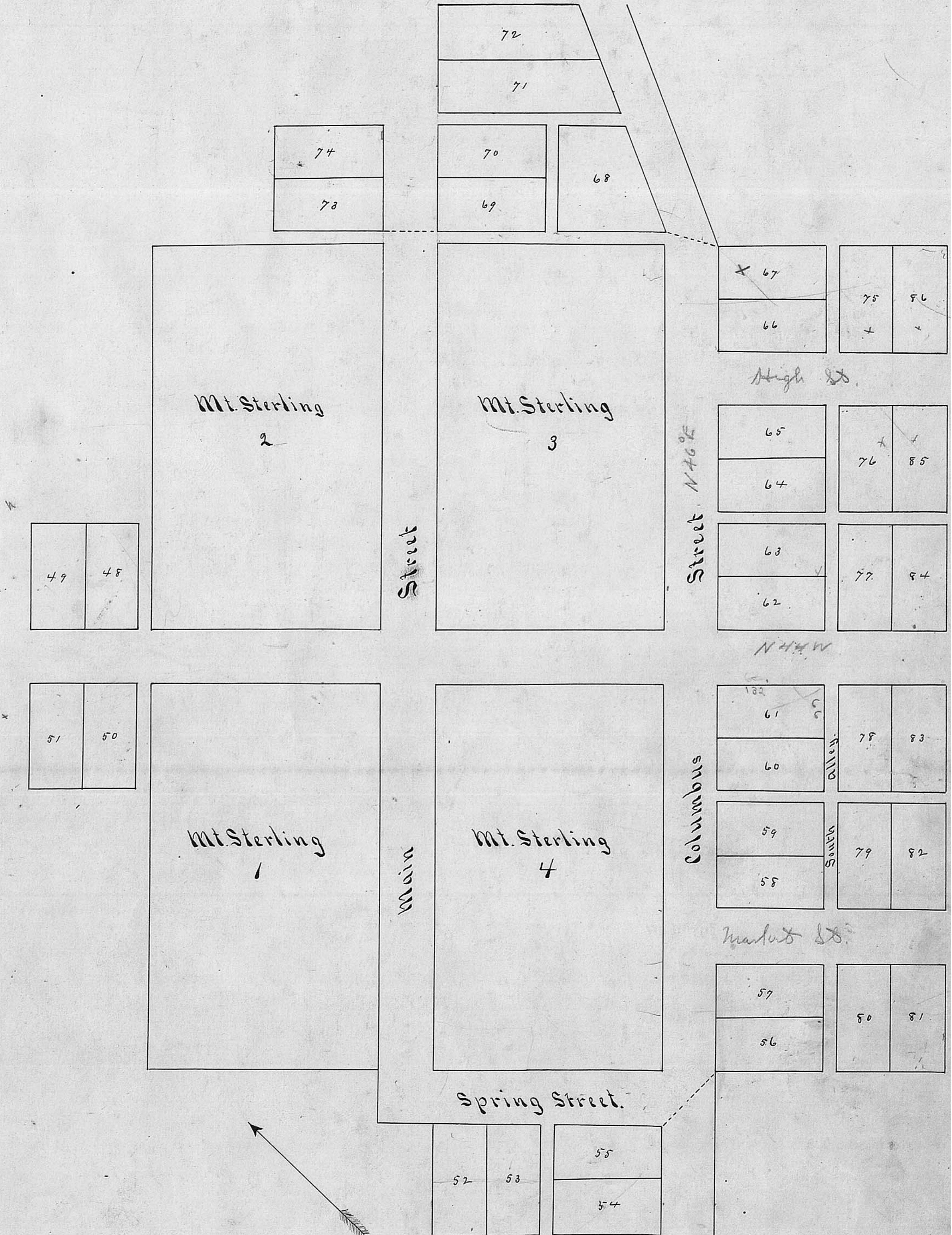


Mt. Sterling

John J. Smiths Addition

Columbus Street runs north 46 E to the northeast corner of Lot No 66 thence runs north 25 East to the southeast corner of Lot No 73 and is 66 feet wide Spring Street runs from the southeast side of Columbus Street to the north west side of main Street as laid off in the original plat and is 66 feet wide Lot 67 runs with Columbus Street N 25 E 140 feet 6 inches thence N 44 W 75 feet with an alley, thence with another alley S 46 W 132 feet to another alley, thence with the same S 44 E 160 feet to the aforesaid Street. Lot No 72 Begins 17 feet N 25 E from the southeast corner of Lot No 67 runs N 25 E 70 feet N 44 W 191 feet to main Street and with the same S 46 W 66 feet to an alley, thence with the same S 44 E 223 feet. No 73 Begins at the South East corner of No 72 and runs north 25 E 70 feet thence North 44 W 159 feet to said main Street and with the same S 46 W 66 feet thence S 44 E 191 feet all the other Lots are 66 feet in front and 132 feet Deep. South alley is 16 1/2 feet wide the Streets and Alleys in the Plat are the width and run the Courses of those in the original Plat. a Stone of about 100 lbs weight has been planted at the North east corner of Lot No 66, which is S 44 E 4 poles from the southeast corner of Lot No 56 as laid off in the original Survey of Mt Sterling. The southwest corner of No 67 is 140 feet 8 inches N 31 W from said Stone. The southeast corner of Lot No 53 is 88 feet 8 inches N 89 W from the southwest corner of Lot No 55. The southeast corner of Lot No 48 is N 44 W 76 1/2 feet from the Northwest corner of Lot No 45 in said town of Mt Sterling at which said point there has been a small Stone planted the southwest corner of Lot No 69, is 66 feet N 44 W from the northwest corner of No 68. 16 1/2 poles N 46 E from the southeast corner of No 23 in said Mt Sterling.

I hereby certify the foregoing plat to be a correct Representation of the Lots Streets and alleys of an addition to the town of Mt Sterling in Madison County and that the descriptions before given is also correct and that a Stone of the Demention aforesaid has been by my direction planted at the northeast corner of said Lot No 66 upon which said Stone the survey is Predicated. Nos 1. 2. 3. 4 in Plat Represents the part appropriated by the said Town of Mt Sterling. April 23. 1836.
