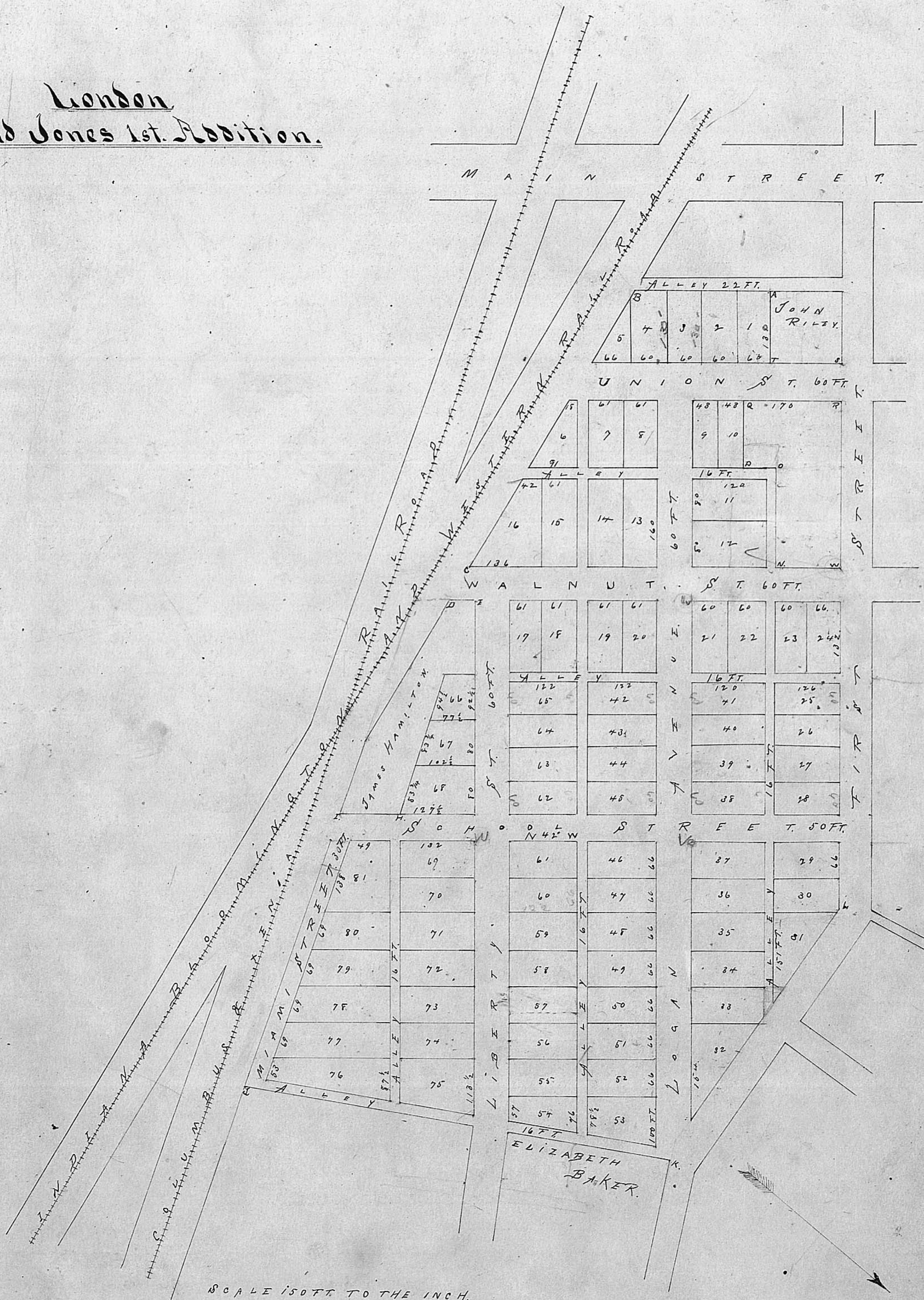

Coland Jones 1st. Addition.



Description of Joland Jones. First addition to the Village of London Ohio. The survey from which the above plat is made is based upon three points marked by iron pins and indicated on the plat by the red letters U. V. & W. The above named addition comprises the area designated by the letters. A. B. C. D. E. F. G. H. I. J. K. L. M. N. O. P. Q. R. S. & T. of the above plat. or that portion of Joland Jones land lying between Elizabeth Bassers Lot and the alley between Main and Union Streets and also between First Street and the north line of the S. B. & W. and the C & X Rail Road.

The position of the lots alleys and Streets. Names of Street. Widths of Streets and alleys. Numbers of Lots and length of Lot lines are indicated in the above plat as follows. Union Street. Walnut Street. and Liberty Street are continuations of Streets of same names of other portions of the village and are each sixty feet in width. Logan Avenue is parallel with that portion of First Street between Main Street and the alley east of the Union School Lot and extends from Union Street to its intersection with First Street and is sixty feet in width. School Street extends from the north line of the C & X R.R. to First Street intersecting at right angles with Liberty Street and Logan Avenue and is fifty feet in width. Miami Street extends from an alley along the south east line of the addition to School Street and is thirty feet in width. The south line of Miami Street is the north line of the C & X R.R. All alleys are sixteen feet in width and their positions are indicated on the above Plat. All measurements are taken from the three initial points. U. V. & W. and the line U. V. and V. W. are the right angle U. V. W. which they form. Lots Nos. 1 & 4 are one hundred and thirty feet in length and sixty feet in width. Lots Nos 6 & 10 are one hundred and thirty feet in length. Lots 7. 8. 13. 14. 15. 17. 18. 19. & 20 are sixty six feet in width. Lots 9 & 10 are forty three feet in width. Lots Nos 11 & 12 are eighty feet in width and one hundred and twenty feet in length. Lots Nos 13 & 16 are one hundred and sixty feet in length. Lots Nos 17 & 24 are one hundred and thirty two feet in length. Lots Nos 21 & 22 are sixty feet in width. Lot No 24 is sixty six feet in width. Lots 25 & 30 are one hundred and twenty six feet in length. Lots Nos 33 & 41 are one hundred and twenty feet in length. Lots Nos 42 & 65 are one hundred and twenty two feet in length. Lots Nos 67 & 75 are one hundred and thirty two feet in length. Lots Nos 25. 28. 38. 41. 42. 45. 62. & 65 are sixty feet in width. Lots Nos 29. 30. 33. 37. 46. 52. 55. 61. 69. 74. 80. & 77 are sixty six feet in width. Lots Nos. 4. 5. 6. 16. 30. 31. 32. 33. 53. 54. 66. 67. 68. 75. 76. 77. 78. 79. 80. & 81 are irregular lots; the front and back lines of which are given in the above plat. The lines of the irregular lots are determined by the bounding lines of streets and alleys and measurement from the corner of the adjoining regular lots. The lines of the regular lots intersected at right angles. The initial points U. V. & W. are located as follows. U is situated at the intersection of the N.E. line of Walnut Street with the N.E. line of Logan Avenue and is a corner to Lot No 21. V is situated at the intersection of the N. W. line of Logan Avenue with the N.E. line of School Street and is corner to Lot No 37. W. is situated at the intersection of the N.E. line of School Street with the S.E. line of Liberty Street. and is a corner to Lot No 69.

London Ohio April 2nd 1887. I hereby certify that the above is a correct plat and description of Joland Jones addition to the Village of London. William Reeder. County Surveyor.

Know all men by these presents. That we Frances A Jones and Joland Jones her husband of London in the County of Madison and State of Ohio have adopted the foregoing Plat and description of Lots. Streets and Alleys. Caused to be laid out by us under the name and title of Joland Jones first addition to the Village of London in said County of Madison and State of Ohio, and submit the same for record in the proper office. In dedicating to public use the streets and alleys therein set forth and described we acknowledge the same to be our free act and deed, for the uses and purposes therein designated. Signed sealed and Acknowledged by us this 4th day of March A.D. 1887.
