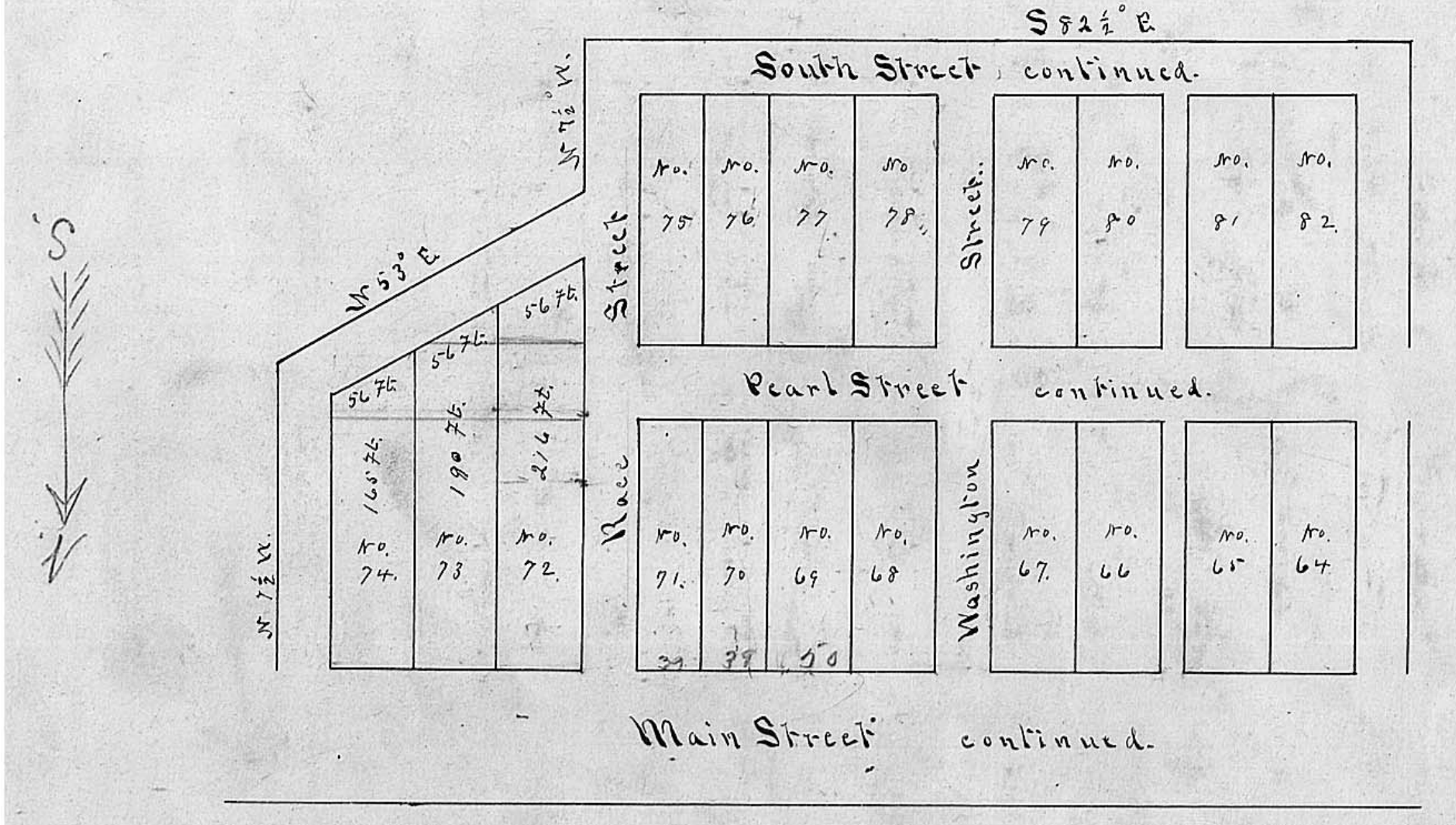


Jones 1st. Addition. Jefferson.



Jefferson. Jones 1st Addition

The above is additional town Lots to Jefferson laid out fifty feet front all except Lots No 70, 71, 75 and 76 which are thirty nine feet in front, running back one hundred and fifty feet, and Lots No 72, 73, and 74. The lines of lot No 74, 165, 190^{ft} No 73 216 feet, No 72, 247 feet back lines crossing at right angles.

Description of the within Plat. - Continuation of the town of Jefferson. Main Street and the Streets and alleys, parallel thereto runs S 82 1/2 W or N 8 3/4 E and Washington Street and the Streets and alleys parallel thereto N 7 1/2 W or S 7 1/2 E. Main street is 80 feet wide, Pearl Street 45, South Street 33 wide, Washington and Race Streets 33 feet wide, all streets and alleys for the use of the public, the lots are 50 feet front and one hundred and fifty feet back, excepting lots 70, 71, 75, and 76 which are 39 feet front. Lots 72, 73, & 74 are fractional lots
