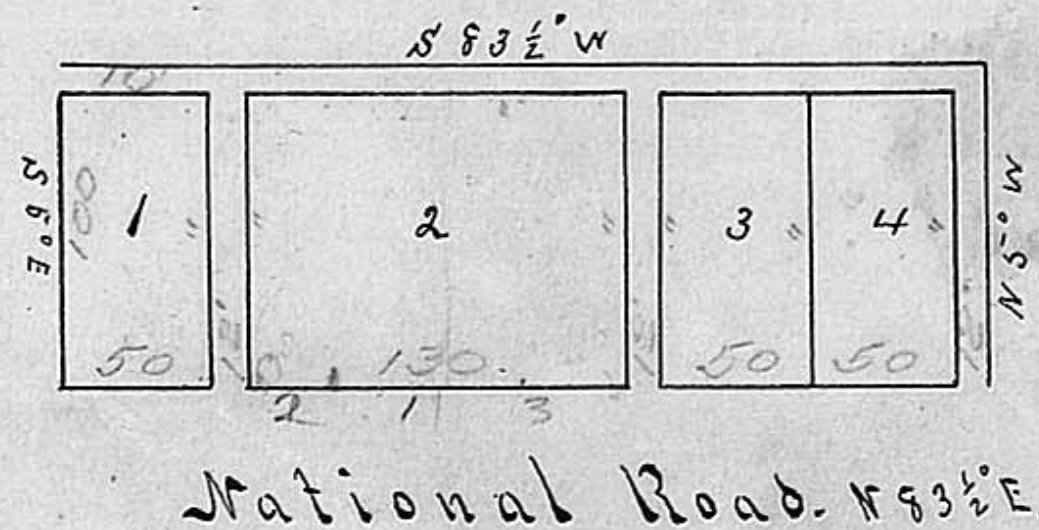

Lots No 1. 3 and 4 fifty feet front and one hundred back. Lot No 2 is one hundred and thirty feet wide and one hundred feet back.
