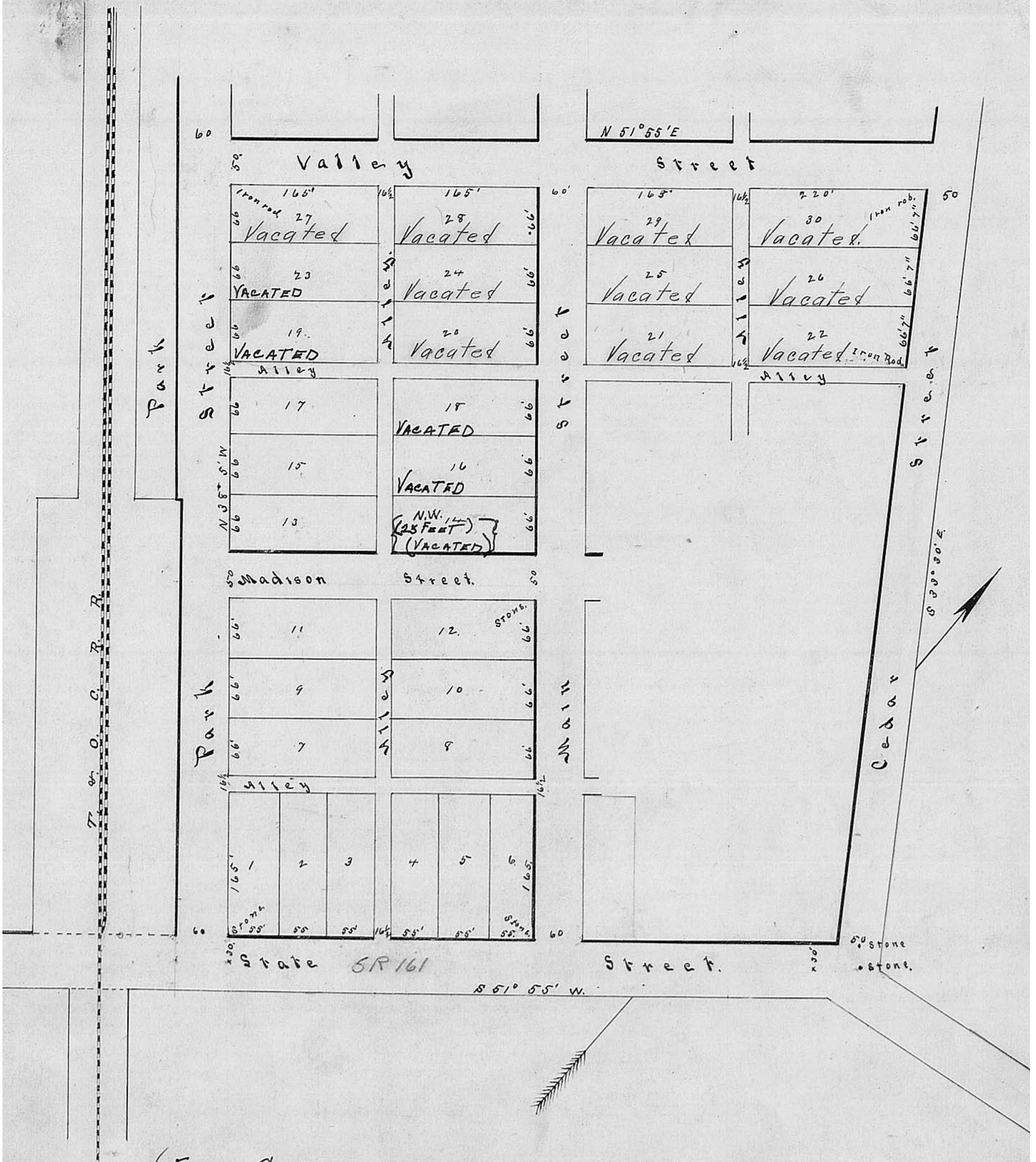

Be it Remembered, That on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October A.D. 1895, before me the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace in and for said County personally came the above named James A. Kile and Mary Kile his wife, grantors in the above instrument and acknowledged the signing of the same to be their voluntary act and deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned.

I hereby certify that on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 1894, I surveyed, and laid out into Lots Streets and alleys for James A. Kile a Town to be called, "Kile" situated in Darby Township Madison County Ohio, and part of Survey no 7074. Bounded and described as follows.

Beginning at a Stake in the center of the State road, and in the easterly line of the Toledo and Ohio Central Rail Road Company's lands; Thence with the easterly line of said lands and the west line of Park Street in said Town to a point opposite and 60 feet distant from the point of intersection of the Easterly line of said Park Street with the northerly line of Valley Street; Thence N 51° 55' E with the northerly line of said Valley Street 900 feet to a stake in the center of the Public Road; Thence with the center of said Road S 33° 31' E 262½ feet to a stake; Thence S 51° 55' W 395 feet to a stake; Thence S 38° 05' E 657½ feet to a stake in the center of said State Road; Thence with the center of said Road S 51° 55' W 466½ feet to the beginning, containing 12<sup>25</sup> Acres more or less.
