Henry Lillys. Addition

Plat and description of Henry Lillys first addition to the Town of Gilroy, it being part of Survey No 10931, originally entered in the name of George Clark and described as follows. Beginning at a stone at the North East corner of Lot No 1. and S 19 1/2 East 42 from the center of the crossing of the London and Georgesville Pike and the Jefferson and Lilly Chapel, California Road and lying in the corner of the London and California Road, road running S 19 1/2 E Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 fronting on said Road, are 60 feet in front running back S 70 W 132 feet and Lot No 14 is 60 feet front and 132 back and Lots No 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 are 60 feet front and 132 feet back with streets 30 feet wide and alleys 12 feet all of which is fully shown by the above Plat.
